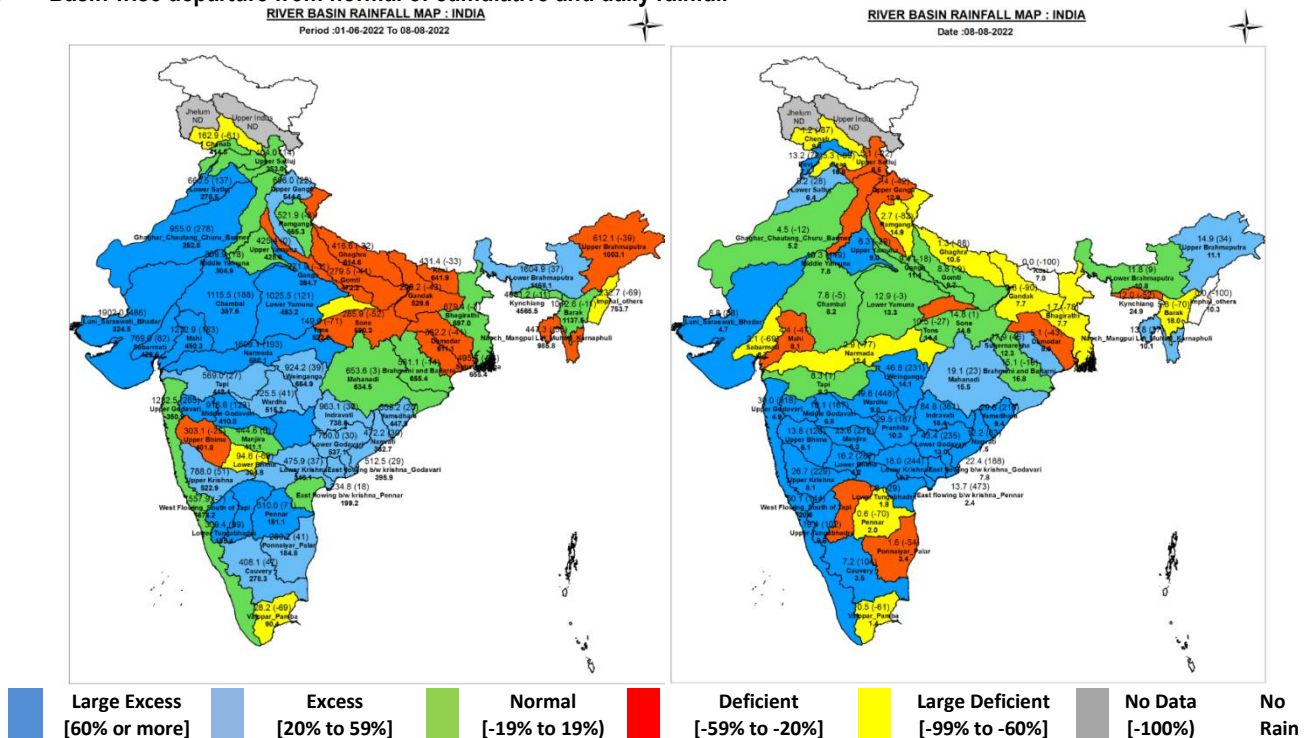

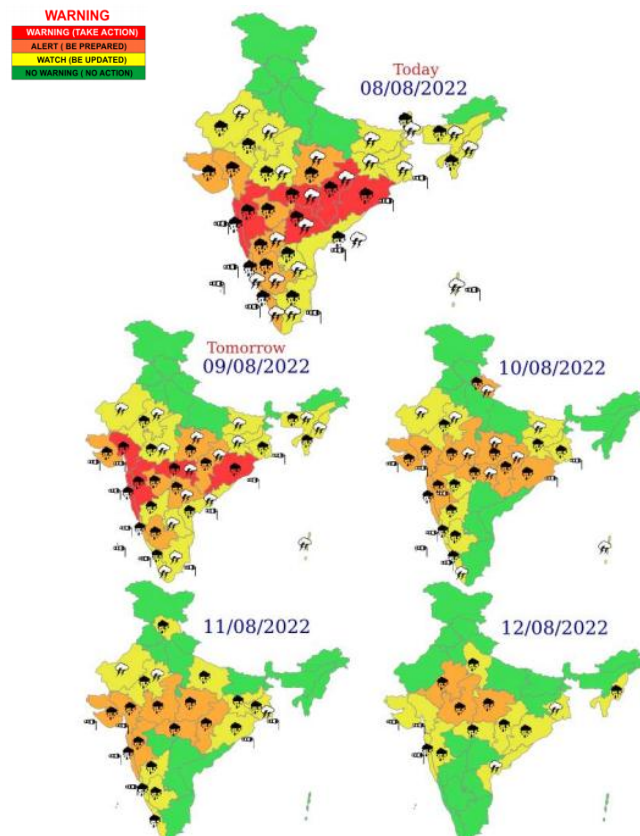
**1.0 Rainfall Situation**

Isolated extremely heavy rainfall over Telangana & Chhattisgarh on 08th; Odisha and Vidarbha on 08th & 09th; Konkan & Goa and ghat areas of Madhya Maharashtra during 08th-10th; Gujarat Region on 09th & 10th and over Saurashtra & Kutch on 10 th August, 2022.

## 2.0 Flood Situation and Advisories

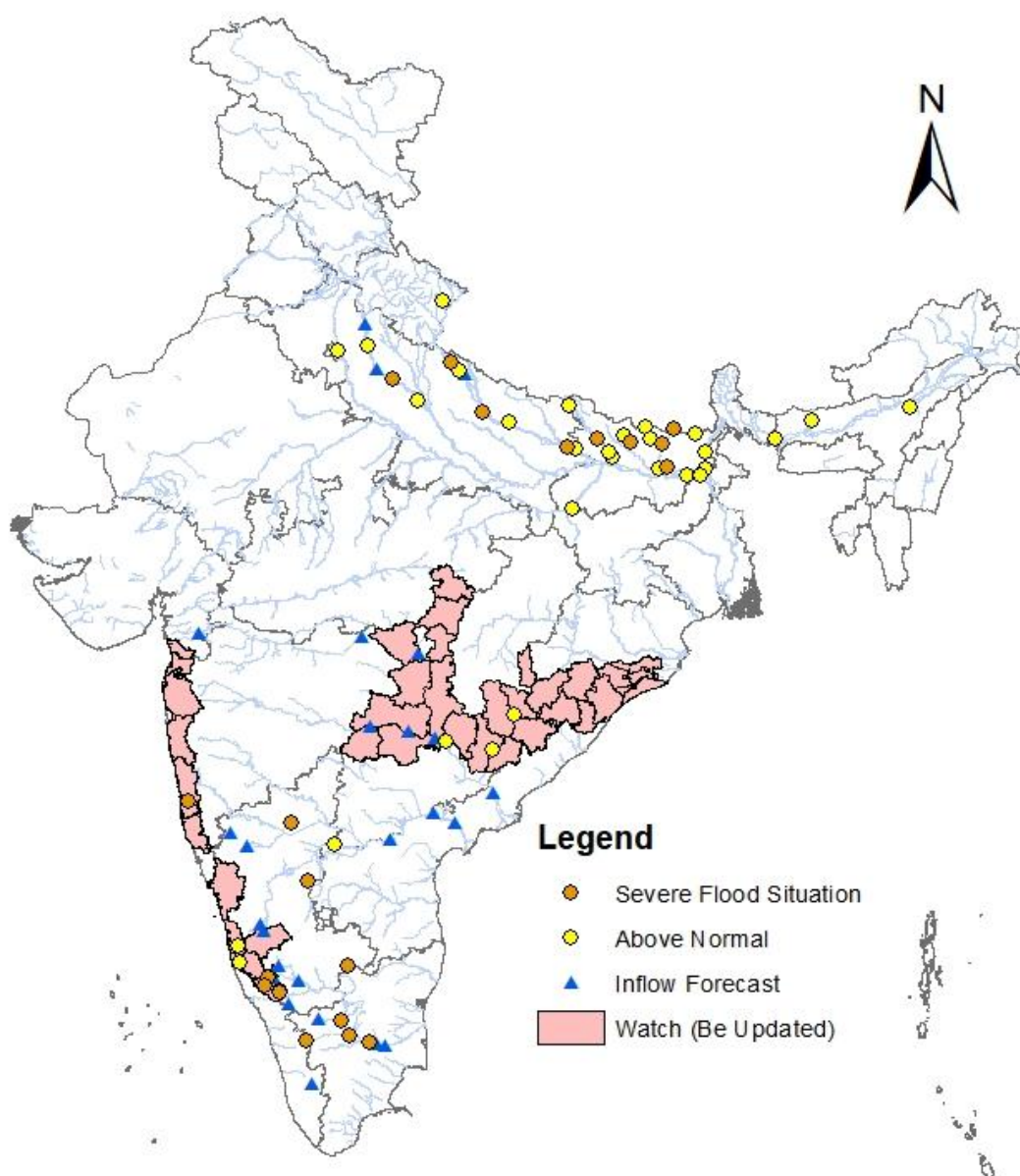
### 2.1 Summary of Flood Situation as per CWC Flood Forecasting Network

On 08<sup>th</sup> August 2022, 10 stations (4 in Bihar, 3 in Uttar Pradesh, 2 in Tamil Nadu & 1 in Chattisgarh) are flowing in Severe Flood Situation, 23 stations (11 in Bihar, 4 in Uttar Pradesh, 3 in Assam and 1 each in Delhi, Jharkhand, Andhra Pradesh & West Bengal) are flowing in Above Normal Flood Situation. Inflow Forecast has been issued for 33 Barrages & Dams (10 in Karnataka, 6 in Telangana, 5 each in Tamil Nadu & Andhra Pradesh, 3 in Uttar Pradesh, 2 in Maharashtra and 1 each in Gujarat & Kerala).

## 2.2 CWC Advisories

### Odisha

Water level may rise in rivers Indravati (**Nawranpur, Koraput** districts), Kolab (**Koraput, Malkangiri** dists.), Nagavalli, Vamsadhara (**Rayagada, Koraput & Gajapati** dists.), Rushikulya (**Ganjam**), Mahanadi (**Puri, Khurda, Nayagarh, Kandhamal & Kalahandi** dists.) and their tributaries in above said districts. Alert for rivers of north Odisha may be kept after 24 hours. As per CWC network, site Shardaput, river Sabari is flowing in severe flood situation with rising trend in **Malkangiri** district.

### Telangana

IMD has predicted very heavy to extremely heavy rains in the state, hence, alert for water level rise may be kept in Godavari basin in districts **Adilabad, B. Kothagudem, Jagital, J. Bhupalpalle, Komaram Bheem, Karimnagar, Mehabubabad, Mancherial, Medak, Mulugu, Nizamabad, Rajanna Sircilla, Peddapalle, Nirmal, Siddipet & Warangal urban** for next 2 to 3 days. Also alert may be kept for water level rise in Krishna basin in districts Rangareddy and Warangal rural.

Major dams with high storage (70%) are Lower Manair, Nizamsagar, Sripadayellampally, Singur, Sriramsagar, KRS Pulichinthala, Jurala, NagarjunaSagar and Srisailem. Dams may be operated as per SOP and releases from the said dams may be done as per SOP after informing lower riparian areas

### Chattisgarh

Water level may rise in rivers of Godavari basin in districts **Bastar, Kandagaon, Dantewada, Kanker, Bijapur, Sukma and Narayanpur**. Flood Situation in the state as per CWC network is as given below:

### Maharashtra

As very heavy to extremely heavy rain are expected in the state for next 2 to 3 days, alert for water level rise may be kept in rivers of Konkan namely Vaitarna, Ulhas, Savitri, Vashisti, Gad, Kali and other small rivers in districts **Thane, Raigad, Ratnagiri, Mumbai and Sindhudurg**. Alert for water level rise may be kept in rivers upper Krishna in **Satara, Kolhapur** districts, river of upper Bhima basins in **Pune** district, river of upper Godavari, Damanganga and Purna in **Nashik, Parbhani and Nanded** districts, river Tapi in **Akola, Amaravathi** districts, river Wainganga in **districts Bhandara, Chandrapur, Gadchiroli, Gondia and Napur**, river Wardha in Wardha district. It is requested to regulate the project as per SOP and any release of water may be done after informing lower riparian areas.

## Karnataka

IMD has predicted very heavy to extremely heavy rains in districts **Uttara Kannada, Shimoga, Udupi, Chikmangalur, Dakshin Kannada, Kodagu, Bidar and Gulbarga for next 2 days**. Alert for water level rise may be kept in rivers Kalinadi, Varahi, Netravathi, Bhadra, Tungabhadra, Ghataprabha, Shimsha, Sharavati, Kumaradhara, Bedthi, Aghanashini, and other tributaries of Krishna and Cauvery rivers in above said districts. Projects such as Linganamakki, Harangi, KRS, Kabini, Hemavathy, Bhadra, Tungabhadra, Ghataprabha, Malaprabha, Almatti and Narayanapura are having high storages, hence, dams may be operated as per SOP and releases from the said dams may be done as per SOP after informing lower riparian areas. ## Gujarat

Alert for water level rise may be kept in rivers such as Banas and Sabarmati in **Banaskantha and Sabarkantha** districts. Also alert may be kept for rise in water levels in Lower Tapi basin & Narmada basin, and rivers Damanganaga, Ambika, Purna, Mindhola, Kaveri, Kharera, Auranga and their tributaries for next 2 days in districts **Tapi, Dangs, Surat, Navsari and Valsad districts**. Alert may be kept for rise in water levels in Shetrunji, Bagod, Malan and other small rivers in **Amreli, Gir-Somnath and Bhavnagar** districts.

## Madhya Pradesh

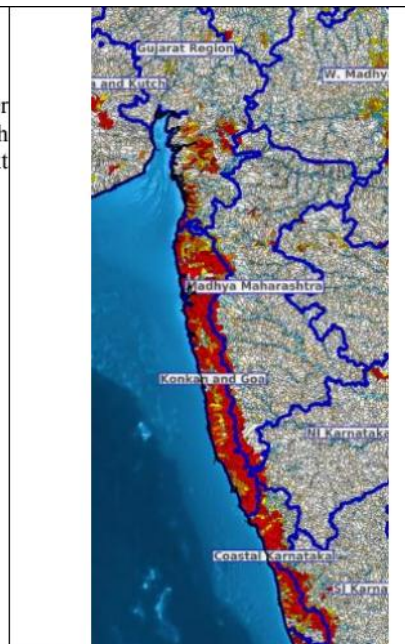
Alert for water level rise may be kept in rivers Chambal basin rivers in **Dhar, Ujjain, Sehore, Dewas** dists., river Narmada in **Sehore, Dhar, Khargone, Dewas, Harda and Narmadapuram** dists., river Mahi in **Dhar** dist., river Tapi in **Burhanpur, Khargone, Betul** dists., river Wainganga in **Balaghat, Mandla** dists., river Ken and Betwa in **Chhatarpur, Sagar** dists.



## 2.3. Flash Flood Guidance

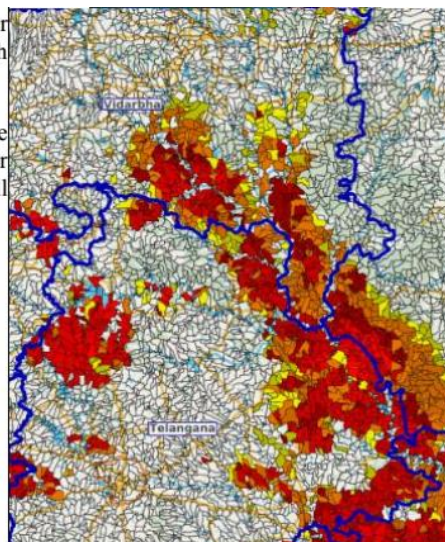
### **24 hours Outlook for the Flash Flood Risk (FFR) till 1130 IST of 09.08.2022:**

**Moderate to High Flash Flood Risk** over Konkan & Goa, Coastal Karnataka and south Gujarat Region Met Sub-division likely in next 24 hours.



**Moderate to High Flash Flood Risk** over Telangana, Vidarbha and south Chhattisgarh Met Sub-division likely in next 24 hours.

Surface runoff/ Inundation may occur at some fully saturated soils & low-lying areas over AoC as shown in map due to expected rainfall occurrence in next 24 hours.
