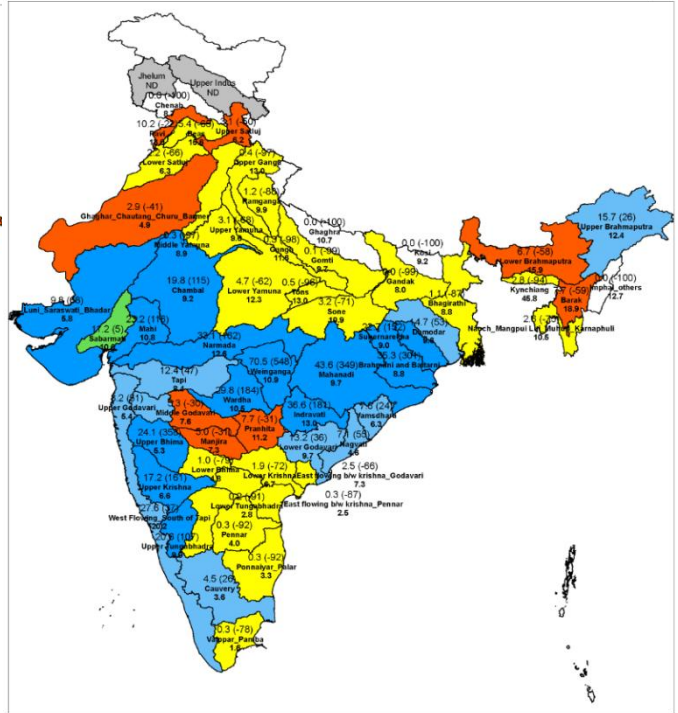

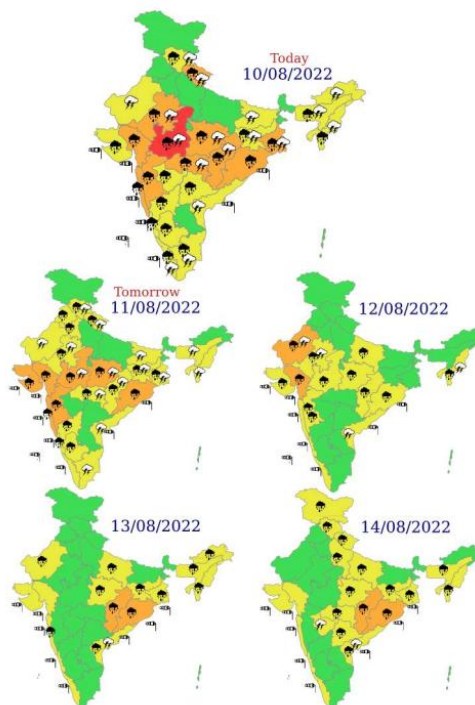

## 2.0 Flood Situation and Advisories

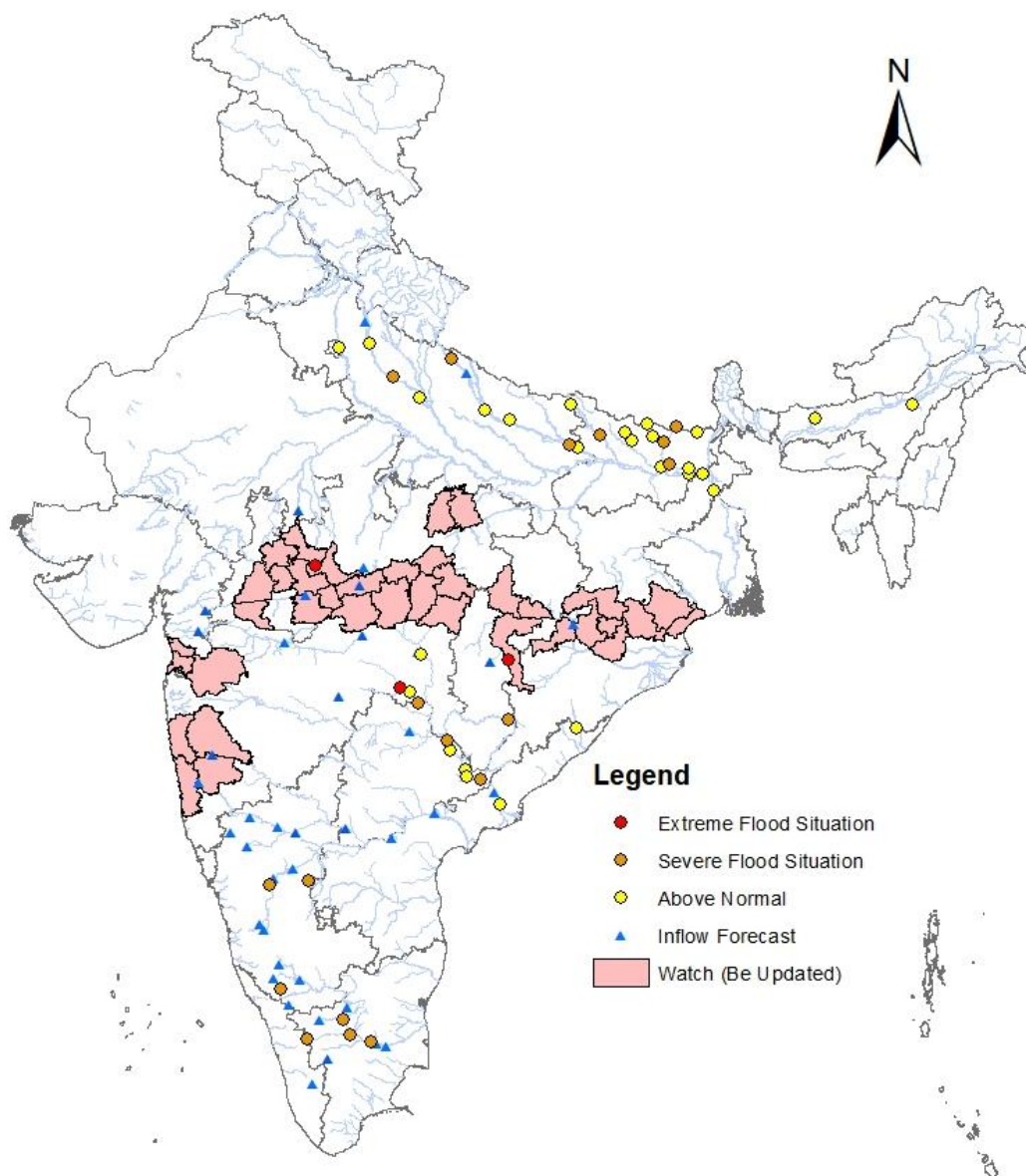
### 2.1 Summary of Flood Situation as per CWC Flood Forecasting Network

On 10<sup>th</sup> August 2022, 12 stations (3 in Bihar, 2 each in Uttar Pradesh, Tamil Nadu & Andhra Pradesh and 1 each in Chhattisgarh, Madhya Pradesh & Telangana) are flowing in Severe Flood Situation, 26 stations (9 in Bihar, 5 in Uttar Pradesh, 3 in Telangana, 2 each in Assam & Maharashtra and 1 each in Delhi, Jharkhand, Andhra Pradesh, Odisha & West Bengal) are flowing in Above Normal Flood Situation. Inflow Forecast has been issued for 44 Barrages & Dams (12 in Karnataka, 6 in Maharashtra, 5 each in Tamil Nadu & Andhra Pradesh, 4 in Telangana, 3 each in Uttar Pradesh & Madhya Pradesh, 2 in Gujarat and 1 each in Rajasthan, Kerala, Chhattisgarh & Odisha).

## 2.2 CWC Advisories

### Madhya Pradesh

Alert for water level rise may be kept in rivers Chambal basin rivers in **Dhar, Ujjain, Dewas, Indore, Agar mawa, Mandsaur, Neemuch, Ratlam, Shajapur** dists., river Narmada in **Dhar, Indore, Khandwa, Katni, Narasingpur, Khargone, Jabalpur, Dewas, Harda and Narmadapuram** dists., river Mahi, Anas in **Dhar, Ratlam** dist., river Tapi in **Burhanpur, Khargone, Barwani, Khandwa, Betul** dists., river Wainganga in **Balaghat, Seoni, Chhindwara, Mandla** dists., river Son in **Umaria, Katni** districts. River Parwati in Chambal basin at CWC site Astha in **Sehore** district is flowing in extreme flood situation.

### Gujarat

Alert for water level rise may be kept in rivers in Mahi, Anas, Sabarmati, Panam in districts **Aravalli, Panchmahal, Dohad, Mahisagar**. Alert for water level rise may be kept in rivers Rukmawati, Khari-Mitti and other small rivers of **Kutch** district. Increased inflows are expected into major dams such as Kadana, Panam, Dharoi, Ukai, Sardar Sarovar & Madhuban.

### Maharashtra

As very heavy rains are expected in the state for next 2 days, alert for water level rise may be kept in rivers of Konkan namely Vaitarna, Ulhas, Savitri, Vashisti, Gad, Kali and other small rivers in districts **Palghar, Raigad, & Ratnagiri**. Alert for water level rise may be kept in rivers upper Krishna in **Satara** district, river of upper Bhima basins in **Pune** district, river of upper Godavari, Damanganga and Purna (Tapi basin Purna river) in **Nashik** district, river Purna (Godavari basin Purna river) in **Amravathi** district, river Wainganga in **district Nagpur**, river Wardha in **Wardha, Amravathi** districts, river Penganga in **Wardha** district. ### Rajasthan

Very heavy rains are expected into Banswara district. Hence alert for water level rise may be kept in Mahi river and heavy inflows into Mahi Bajaj Sagar Dam is expected. In Chambal and its tributaries, alert for water level rise may be expected in **Jhalawar, Baran, Kota and Bhundi** districts as the upper part of Chambal is getting very heavy rains.

## Odisha

Alert for water level rise may be kept in rivers, Mahanadi (**Balasore, Sundargarh, Jharsuguda, Bargarh, Sambalpur dists.**), Brahmani & Baitarni (**Balsore, Sundargarh, Sambalpur, Angul, Keojarah dists.**), Burhabalanga (**Myurbhanj, Balosore dists.**), Subarnarekha (**Myurbhanj, Balosore dists.**) and their tributaries in above said districts.

## Chattisgarh

In rivers of Mahanadi basin alert for water level rise may be kept in **Bilaspur, Mungeli, Janjgir, Balodabazar & Mahasamund** districts. Flood Situation in the state as per CWC network is as given below:

## Telangana

Due to propagation of flood wave raised in Maharashtra and Chattisgarh downstream lower Godavari in Telangana is affected by flood situation in **Mulugu, Kmaram Bheem, Bhadradi and Khammam** districts and is expected to continue for next two days.

## Andra Pradesh

Due to propagation of flood wave raised in Maharashtra and Chattisgarh, downstream areas of lower Godavari in **Alluri Sitharama Raju and East Godavari districts** are having above normal flood situation. Water levels of Godavari in above said districts are expected to rise further in next 2 days.

## Tamilnadu

IMD has predicted very heavy rains in districts **Nilgris and Coimbatore** next 2 days hence alert for water level rise may be kept in rivers Cauvery, Parambikulam, Aliyar, and Pandipuzha and the tributaries of said rivers in above said districts.

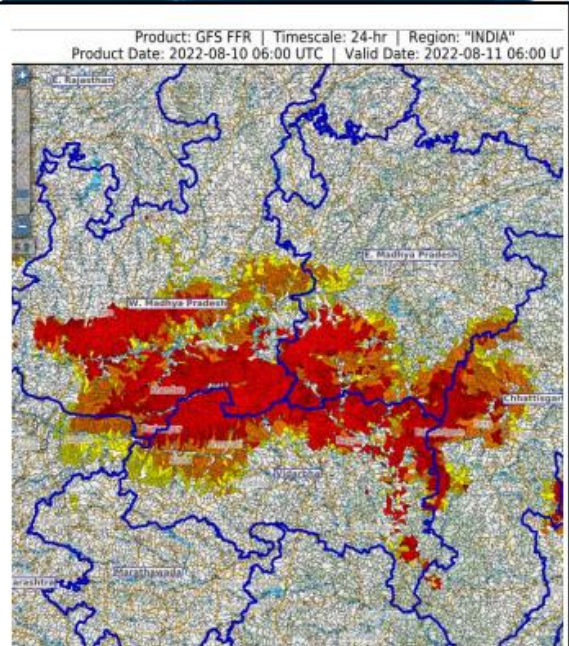


## 2.3. Flash Flood Guidance

### **24 hours Outlook for the Flash Flood Risk (FFR) till 1130 IST of 11.08.2022:**

**Moderate to High Flash Flood Risk** over South Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, South Chhattisgarh Met Sub-division likely in next 24 hours.

Surface runoff/ Inundation may occur at some fully saturated soils & low-lying areas over AoC as depicted in map due to persistent rainfall in next 24 hours.
