



Central Water Commission Daily Flood Situation Report cum Advisories 11-08-2022

 Isolated very heavy rainfall over Jammu & Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand on Madhya Maharashtra, Gangetic West Bengal, Coastal & South Interior Karnataka and Konkan & Goa on 11th; East Madhya Pradesh and Vidarbha on 14th & 15th; West Madhya Pradesh and East Rajasthan on 11th & 15th; Chhattisgarh on 14th; Odisha on 13th & 14thAugust, 2022.


2.1 Summary of Flood Situation as per CWC Flood Forecasting Network

On 11th August 2022, 13 stations (4 in Bihar, 2 each in Uttar Pradesh, Tamilnadu, Telangana & Andhra Pradesh and 1 Telangana) are flowing in Severe Flood Situation, 23 stations (6 in Bihar, 5 in Uttar Pradesh, 4 in Telangana, 2 in Assam and 1each in Jharkhand, Maharashtra & West Bengal) are flowing in Above Normal Flood Situation. Inflow Forecast has been issued for 50 Barrages & Dams (13 in Karnataka, 7 in Maharashtra, 5 each in Madhya Pradesh, Tamilnadu & Andhra Pradesh 4 each in Telangana & Uttar Pradesh, 2 each in Odisha & Gujarat and 1 each in Chattisgarh, Rajasthan & Jharkhand).

2.2 CWC Advisories

Madhya Pradesh

Alert for water level rise may be kept in rivers Chambal basin rivers in **Dhar, Ujjain, Dewas, Indore, Agar Malwa, Mandsaur, Neemuch, Ratlam, Shajapur** dists., river Narmada in **Dhar, Indore, Khandwa, Katni, Narasingpur, Khargone, Jabalpur, Dewas** dists., river Mahi, Anas in **Dhar, Ratlam, Jhabua** dist., river Tapi in **Burhanpur, Khargone, Barwani, Khandwa** dists., river Wainganga in **Balaghat, Seoni, Chhindwara, Mandla** dists., river Son in **Katni** district. At CWC site Burhanpur in **Rajgarh** district, river Tapi is flowing in severe flood situation with falling trend.

Gujarat

As there is heavy rainfall in upper Sabarmati, upper & middle Tapi, middle Narmada and upper Mahi and in Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh and Maharashtra, alert for water level rise may be kept in rivers in Mahi, Anas, Sabarmati, Damanganga, Tapi & Narmada. Increased inflows are expected into major dams such as Kadana, Panam, Dharoi, Ukai, Sardar Sarovar & Madhuban.

Maharashtra

As very heavy rains are expected in the state for next 2 days, alert for water level rise may be kept in rivers of Konkan namely Vaitarna, Ulhas, Savitri, Vashisti, Gad, Kali and other small rivers in districts **Palghar, Raigad, & Ratnagiri**. Alert for water level rise may be kept in rivers upper Krishna in **Satara** district, river of upper Bhima basins in **Pune** district, river of upper Godavari, Damanganga and Purna(Tapi basin Purna river) in **Nashik** districtList of dams with more than 70% Storage in districts with heavy rain warning are listed below:

Rajasthan

Very heavy rains are expected into **Udaipur**, **Dungarpur** and **Banswara** district. Hence alert for water level rise may be kept in Sabarmati and Mahi river and heavy inflows into Mahi Bajaj Sagar Dam (**Banswara** dist.) is expected. In Chambal and its tribuatries, alert for water level river may be kept since there are heavy rains in west Madhya Pradesh.

Karnataka

IMD has predicted very heavy to extremely heavy rains in districts **Uttara Kannada**, **Shimoga**, **Udupi**, **Chikmangalur**, **Dakshin Kannada and Kodagu**, **for next 2 days**. Alert for water level rise may be kept in rivers Kalinadi, Varahi, Netravathi, Bhadra, Tungabhadra, Ghataprabha, Shimsha, Sharavati, Kumaradhara, Bedthi, Aghanashini, and other tributaries of Krishna and Cauvery rivers in above said districts. Projects such as Harangi, KRS, Kabini, Hemavathy, Bhadra, Tungabhadra, Ghataprabha, Almatti and Narayanapura are having high storages hence dams may be operated as per SOP and releases from the said dams may be done as per SOP after informing lower riparian areas. 

2.3. Flash Flood Guidance

24 hours Outlook for the Flash Flood Risk (FFR) till 1130 IST of 12.08.2022:

Moderate Flood Risk over West Madhya Pradesh, adjoining south Rajasthan, south Gujasrat, south Saurashtra & Kutch, Konkan & Goa, Met Sub-division likely in next 24 hours.

Surface runoff/ Inundation may occur at some fully saturated soils & low-lying areas over AoC as depicted in map due to persistent rainfall in next 24 hours.
