



2.0 Flood Situation and Advisories


2.1 Summary of Flood Situation as per CWC Flood Forecasting Network

On 12thJuly 2023, 1 station in Delhi is flowing in Extreme Flood Situation, 5 stations (3 in Assam & 2 in Uttar Pradesh) are flowing in Severe Flood Situation, 21 stations (10 in Assam, 5 in Bihar, 3 each in Uttar Pradesh & West Bengal) are flowing in Above Normal Flood Situation. Inflow Forecast has been issued for 9 Dams and Barrages (3 in Uttar Pradesh, 2 each in TamilNadu & Karnataka and 1 in Odisha)

2.2 CWC Advisories

Uttarakhand

IMD has predicted very heavy rains in **Pauri Garhwal, Nainital, Champawat and Udham Singh Nagar districts** for next two days. Keep watch for water level rise in rivers such as Gola, Ramganga, Kosi, Fica, Sarda, Sarju, Deoha and other tributaries of rivers in upper Ganga. Since the rainfall has decreased over the region water level is expected to have steady to decreasing condition in coming hours. Current flood situation as per CWC network is given below:

New Delhi

River Yamuna in Ganga basin at Delhi Railway Bridge in NORTH district of Delhi continues to flow in Extreme flood situation at 18:00 hrs today. At 18:00 hrs, it was flowing at a level of 207.81 m with Rising (39.99 mm/hr) trend which is 2.48 m above its Danger Level of 205.33 m and 0.32 m above its previous HFL of 207.49 m (06-09-1978).

Uttar Pradesh

IMD has predicted very heavy rains for next two days in districts **Bareilly**, **Pilhibhit**, **Shahjahanpur**, **Kheri**, **Bahraich**, **Shrawasti**, **Sitapur**. Alert for water level rise may be kept in rivers Ramganga, Sai, Gaghra, Gomti, Mahakali and other small rivers over the region.

Due to downward propagation of floods in Yamuna water level is expected to rise in lower riparian regions. Current flood situation as per CWC network is given below:

Bihar

Due to heavy rains predicted in Nepal and in districts such as **West and East Champaran**, **Sheohar**, **Sitamarhi**, **Madhubani**, **Supaul**, **Sahara**, **Madhapura**, **Araria**, **Purnea**, **Kathihar and Kishanganj**, keep alert for water level rise in north tributaries of river Ganga such as Bagmati, Adhwara, Kamlabalan, Kosi, Mahananda and other small rivers over the region. Current flood situation as per CWC network is given below:

Sub Himalayan West Bengal

IMD has predicted very heavy rainfall over districts such as **Jalpaiguri**, **Alipurduar**, **Coochbihar**, **Darjeeling**, **Kalimpong** and **in Sikkim** water level rise is expected in rivers such as Jaldhaka, Raidak, Torsa, Sankosh and Teesta in above said districts. Current flood situation as per CWC network is given below:

Assam

IMD has predicted very heavy rainfall over Sikkim and districts such as **Kokrajhar**, **Chirang**, **Baksa**, **Barpeta**, **Bongaigaon**, for next 2 days, hence water level rise is expected in Brahamputra and its tributaries such as Puthimari, Aie, Beki, Manas, Pagladiya, Kopili, Sankosh, and other small tributaries located in above said districts. Current flood situation as per CWC site network is as given below:



Moderate flash flood risk likely over few watersheds & neighbourhoods of Uttarakhand Met Sub-divisions during next 24 hours.


Surface runoff/ Inundation may occur at some fully saturated soils & low-lying areas over AoC as shown in map due to expected rainfall occurrence in next 24 hours.



24 hours Outlook for the Flash Flood Risk (FFR) till 1130 IST of 13-07-2023 :

Moderate flash flood risk likely over few watersheds & neighbourhoods of SHWB & Sikkim Adjoining extreme NE Bihar, NE Assam & S Meghalaya and NE Arunachal Pradesh Met Sub-divisions during next 24 hours.



24 hours Outlook for the Flash Flood Risk (FFR) till 1130 IST of 13-07-2023 :

Moderate flash flood risk likely over few watersheds & neighbourhoods of Coastal Karnataka and S Konkan & Goa Met Subdivisions during next 24 hours.

Surface runoff/ Inundation may occur at some fully saturated soils & low-lying areas over AoC as shown in map due to expected rainfall occurrence in next 24 hours.
