


# Central Water Commission Daily Flood Situation Report cum Advisories 14-08-2022


#### 1.0 Rainfall Situation

#### 1.1 Basin wise departure from normal of cumulative and daily rainfall

#### 1.2 Rainfall forecast for next 5 days issued on 14th August 2022 (Midday) by IMD



- i) Isolated very heavy rainfall over Uttarakhand, West Madhya Pradesh, south Jharkhand, Gangetic West Bengal and Telangana on 14th; Konkan & Goa, East Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha & Chhattisgarh on 15th; Madhya Maharashtra during 14th -16th; Himachal Pradesh on 14th & 15th; Odisha on 18th; East Rajasthan and West Madhya Pradesh on 14th & 16th; West Rajasthan on 16th August, 2022.
- ii) Isolated extremely heavy rainfall over Odisha, East Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha & Chhattisgarh on 14th and over East Rajasthan and West Madhya Pradesh on 15th August, 2022.

#### 2.0 Flood Situation and Advisories


#### 2.1 Summary of Flood Situation as per CWC Flood Forecasting Network

On 14th August 2022, 7 stations (2 in Bihar & Odisha and 1 each in Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan & Andhra Pradesh) are flowing in Severe Flood Situation, 23 stations (5 in Bihar & Uttar Pradesh, 3 in Telangana & Andhra Pradesh, 2 in Tamil Nadu & Odisha and 1 each in Delhi, Assam & West Bengal) are flowing in Above Normal Flood Situation. Inflow Forecast has been issued for 35 Barrage & Dams (12 in Karnataka, 6 in Maharashtra, 5 in Andhra Pradesh, 3 in Telangana & Tamilnadu, 2 each in Madhya Pradesh, Gujarat & Odisha).

#### 2.2 CWC Advisories

#### Odisha

Alert for water level rise may be kept in rivers, Mahanadi (Jagatsinghapur, Pulbani, Cuttack, Bargarh, Sambalpur, Angul, Sonepur, Boudh, Nuapada, Bolangir, Kalahandi, Jharsuguda, Sundargarh, Kandhamal, Puri, Khurda and Nayagarh), Brahmani & Baitarni (Balsore, Mayurbhanj, Bhadrak, Keonjhar, Sundargarh, Sambalpur, Deograh, Angul, Jajpur, Kendrapara, Dhenkanal dists.), Burhabalanga (Myurbhanj, Balosore dists.), Subarnarekha (Balosore, Mayurbhanj dist.), Indravathi (Nawranpur, Koraput, Rayagada dists.), Nagavalli (Rayagarh, Kalahandi, Koraput, dist.), Vamsadhara (Rayagarh, Gajapati, Phulbani dists.), Rushikulya (Ganjam, Gajapati, Phunlbani dist.), Kolab (Koraput, Malkangiri dists.) and their tributaries in above said districts. Since Odisha region has already faced a heavy rainfall scenario in immediate past, more alert may be kept for the incoming rainfall scenario since the surface flow will be more.

#### Chhattisgarh

In rivers of Mahanadi basin alert for water level rise may be kept in **Bilaspur**, **Balodabazar**, **Korba**, **Gariaband**, **Dhamtari**, **and Kanker** districts. Also alert for water level rise in Godavari basin may be kept in **Baster**, **Kondagaon**, **Dantewada**, **Kanker**, **Bijapur and Narayanpur** districts.

#### Madhya Pradesh

Alert for water level rise may be kept river Narmada in Raisen, Dindori, Jabalpur, Chhindwara, Katni, Annupur, Narasingpur, Khargone, Jabalpur, Mandla, Dewas, Harda dists., river Chambal in Raisen, Sehore, Dewas, Guna, Shivpuri, Morena, Sheopur dists., river Wainganga in Balaghat, Seoni, Chhindwara, Mandla dists., river Son in Umaria, Katni, Annupur, Shahdol dists., river Betwa in Vidisha, Chhatarpur, Sagar dists., river Ken in Panna, Damoh, Katni dists., river Sindh in Vidisha, Guna, Gwalior, Shivpuri, Datia, Bhind, Morena districts.

#### **Maharashtra**

As very heavy rains are expected in the state for next 2 days, alert for water level rise may be kept in rivers of Konkan namely Vaitarna, Ulhas, Savitri, Vashisti, Gad, Kali and other small rivers in districts **Palghar**, **Raigad**, & **Ratnagiri**. Alert for water level rise may be kept in rivers upper Krishna in **Satara** district, river of upper Bhima basins in **Pune** district, river Wainganga in districts **Bhandara**, **Chandrapur**, **Gadchiroli**, **Gondia** and **Nagpur**.

#### Telangana

IMD has predicted very heavy rains in the state, hence, alert for water level rise may be kept in Godavari basin in districts Adilabad, B. Kothagudem, Jagital, J. Bhupalpalle, Komaram Bheem, Karimnagar, Mancherial, Mulugu, Hanamkonda & Khammam. Also alert for water level rise may be kept in Krishna basin in Jangaon district for 2 days. Since last weeks flood wave raised in Maharashtra and Chattisgarh are still flowing through Mulugu and B.Kothagudem districts and the current spell is expected to create another flood wave. Hence more watch should be kept in Mulugu and B.Kothagudem districts.

#### Rajasthan

Alert for water level rise may be kept in rivers Chambal in districts **Kota, Baran & Bundi**, Banganga and Ruparail in districts **Dausa and Alwar**. At CWC site Dholpur in **Dholpur** district river Chambal is flowing in severe flood situation with falling trend.

#### **Himachal Pradesh**

Alert for water level rise may be kept in rivers Satiuj, Tons, Beas and its tributaries in districts **Hamirpur**, **Champa**, **Kangra**, **Mandi**, **Solan**, **Shimla**, **Kullu** and **Sirmaur** districts.

#### Delhi

CWC site Delhi Railway Bridge on river Yamuna in **North Delhi** district is in above normal flood situation with steady trend.


#### 2.3. Flash Flood Guidance

## 24 hours Outlook for the Flash Flood Risk (FFR) till 1130 IST of 15.08.2022:

Moderate to High Flash Flood Risk over Odisha, South Jharkhand, and Chhattisgarh Met Sub-divisions likely in next 24 hours.

Moderate Flash Flood Risk over East Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, West Bengal, north Telangana, north Coastal Andhra Pradesh and Uttarakhand Met Sub-division likely in next 24 hours.

Surface runoff/ Inundation may occur at some fully saturated soils & low-lying areas over AoC as depicted in map due to persistent rainfall in next 24 hours.
