


# Central Water Commission Daily Flood Situation Report cum Advisories 20-07-2022

#### 1.0 Rainfall Situation


#### 1.1 Basin wise departure from normal of cumulative and daily rainfall

- ii) Isolated very heavy rainfall over Assam & Meghalaya and East Uttar Pradesh on 20th; Arunachal Pradesh, Punjab, Haryana-Chandigarh, West Uttar Pradesh & Himachal Pradesh on 20th & 21st; Uttarakhand during 21st -23rd July, 2022.


#### 2.1 Summary of Flood Situation as per CWC Flood Forecasting Network

On 20th July 2022, 4 stations (1 each in Andhra Pradesh, Bihar, Tamilnadu & Telangana) are flowing in Severe Flood Situation, 15 stations (4 in Bihar, 3 each in Andhra Pradesh & Telangana, 2 each in Assam & Uttar Pradesh and 1 in Maharashtra) are flowing in Above Normal Flood Situation. Inflow Forecast has been issued for 30 Barrages & Dams (13 in Karnataka, 5 in Tamil Nadu, 4 in Telangana, 3 in Andhra Pradesh and 1 each in Gujarat, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Odisha & Uttar Pradesh).

#### 2.2 CWC Advisories

#### Maharashtra

Wardha river (Godavai basin) is flowing in extreme flood situation in Chadrapur district and water level is in falling trend. Since the rainfall has decreased over the region, the flood levels are expected to recede gradually in coming days if no further rainfall scenario occurs over the region in next few days.

#### Telangana

Districts of Telangana in Godavari basin such as **Bhadradri**, **Mulugu**, **Kumaram Bheem** are in above normal flood situation and expected to fall very slowly in 3 to 4 days.

#### **Andhra Pradesh**

Flood wave in Godavari basin that rose in Maharashtra and Telegana regions are travelling downstream, hence, there is flood situation in **East Godavari** and **Alluri Sitharama Raju** districts. Water levels are in falling trend and is expected to recede very slowly. Flood situation as per CWC network is included in below given table.

#### Uttarakhand

IMD has predicted increase in rainfall in almost all districts mainly in **Dedradun, Tehri Garhwal, Pauri Garhwal, Haridwar, Nainital, Champawat, Udham Singh Nagar,** hence, alert for water level rise may be kept in rivers upper Ganga, Ramganga and its tributaries in above said districts. Ramganga river is flowing in severe flood situation in **Pithogarh** district.

#### **Himachal Pradesh**


Alert for water level rise may be kept in rivers Satiuj, Tons, Beas and its tributaries in districts **Una**, **Mandi**, **Bilaaspur**, **Simla**, **Solan** and **Sirmaur**.

#### 2.3 Flash Flood Guidance

## 24 hours Outlook for the Flash Flood Risk (FFR) till 1130 IST of 21.07.2022:

Moderate Risk over few Watersheds & neighborhoods of Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand Met subdivisions in next 24 hours.

Surface runoff/ Inundation may occur at some fully saturated soils & low-lying areas over AoC as shown in map due to expected rainfall occurrence in next 24 hours.
