



# Central Water Commission Daily Flood Situation Report cum Advisories 23-07-2022

- Isolated very heavy rainfall over Gujarat Region, Rajasthan, East Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Odisha, Vidarbha and Coastal Andhra Pradesh on 23rd and Saurashtra & Kutch and West Madhya Pradesh on 23rd & 24th July, 2022.
- ii. Isolated extremely heavy rainfall over Telangana during 23rd -25th July, 2022


#### 2.1 Summary of Flood Situation as per CWC Flood Forecasting Network

On 23<sup>rd</sup> July 2022, 2 stations (1 in Bihar) are flowing in Severe Flood Situation, 17 stations (5 each in Uttar Pradesh & Bihar, 4 in Assam, 2 in Andhra Pradesh and 1 in Telangana) are flowing in Above Normal Flood Situation. Inflow Forecast has been issued for 31 Barrages & Dams (7 in Karnataka, 6 in Telangana, 4 each in Tamil Nadu & Andra Pradesh, 3 each in Madhya Pradesh & Uttar Pradesh and 1 each in Gujarat, Maharashtra, Odisha & Rajasthan).

#### 2.2 CWC Advisories

#### **Telangana**

Since IMD has predicted extremely heavy to very heavy rains over many districts of the state especially in Adilabad, Jagital, Bhupalpally, Karimnagar, Khammam, Komaram Bheem, Mahabubabad, Mancherial, Nirmal, Pedapally, Rajanna Sircilla and Warangal for next 2 days, alert for water level rise may be kept in river Godavari and Krishna and its tributaries in all most all districts. In Godavari basin due to flood of near past, soil moisture is very high and hence the surface flow created by any intense rainfall event is expected to be very high, hence all preparations to handle the situation may be taken.

#### **Andhra Pradesh**

Flood wave in Godavari basin that rose in Maharashtra and Telegana regions are travelling downstream, hence, there is flood situation in **East Godavari** and **Alluri Sitharama Raju** districts. Flood situation in Godavari will continue for next 1 or 2 days.. Flood situation as per CWC network is included in below given table. IMD has predicted very heavy rains in **Krishna and Guntur** districts, alert may be kept for water level rise in Krishna and other small rivers in above said districts.

#### **Gujarat**

Alert for water level rise may be kept in rivers Banas, Sabarmati, Rel and other small rivers in **Banaskantha and Sabarkantha** districts, also keep alert of water level rise in rivers of **Kutch** districts like Rukmavati, Khari-Mitti and other small rivers in the area.

#### Jammu Kashmir

Alert for water level rise may be kept in rivers Jhelum, Chenab and their tributaries in districts Muzaffarabad, Poonch, Mirpur, Rajouri, Reasi, Jammu, Udhampur, Samba, Kathua, Doda and Kishtwar.

#### **Maharashtra**

IMD has predicted heavy rains in Chandrapur and Gadchiroli hence alert may be kept for water level rise in river Wardha and lower Wainganga. The said rivers are now highly sensitive due to flood of near past. Soil moisture is very high and hence the surface flow created by any intense rainfall event is expected to be very high, hence all preparations to handle the situation may be taken.

#### Chattisgarh

IMD has predicted heavy rains in **Balod**, **Kanker**, **Rajnandgaon and Narayanpur** hence alert for water level rise may be kept in rivers Mahanadi, Godavari and their tributaries in the said districts.

#### Madhya Pradesh

IMD has predicted heavy rains in **Bhopal**, **Raisen**, **Rajgarh**, **Vidisha**, **Shore**, **Betul**, **Harda and Narmadapuram**, hence alert for water level rise may be kept in rivers Parbati, Kalisindh, Tapi, Narmada and upper Betwa and its tributaries over the said regions.

## 24 hours Outlook for the Flash Flood Risk (FFR) till 1130 IST of 24.07.2022:


Moderate Risk over western parts of Jammu & Kashmir, Uttarakhand and Himachal Pradesh Met subdivisions in next 24 hours.

Surface runoff/ Inundation may occur at some fully saturated soils & low-lying areas over AoC as shown in map due to expected rainfall occurrence in next 24 hours.

### 24 hours Outlook for the Flash Flood Risk (FFR) till 1130 IST of 24.07.2022:

Moderate Risk over northern watersheds of Telangana and adjoining few watersheds of Marathawada and adjoining Vidarbha Met subdivisions in next 24 hours.

Surface runoff/ Inundation may occur at some fully saturated soils & low-lying areas over AoC as shown in map due to expected rainfall occurrence in next 24 hours.
