


# Central Water Commission Daily Flood Situation Report cum Advisories 24-07-2022

#### 1.0 Rainfall Situation


#### 1.1 Basin wise departure from normal of cumulative and daily rainfall

#### 1.2 Rainfall forecast for next 5 days issued on 24th July 2022 (Midday) by IMD



- Isolated extremely heavy rainfall over Gujarat State and southwest Madhya Pradesh on 24th July, 2022.
- Isolated very heavy rainfall over West Rajasthan, north Konkan, northern parts of ghat areas of Madhya Maharashtra & Vidarbha on 24th; over East Rajasthan on 24th & 25th and over West Madhya Pradesh and Gujarat State on 25th July, 2022.


#### 2.1 Summary of Flood Situation as per CWC Flood Forecasting Network

On 24th July 2022, 1station (1 inBihar) is flowing in Severe Flood Situation, 18 stations (7 in Bihar, 5 in Uttar Pradesh, 4 in Assam and 2 in Andhra Pradesh) are flowing in Above Normal Flood Situation. Inflow Forecast has been issued for 30 Barrages & Dams (7 in Karnataka, 5 each in Telangana & Andhra Pradesh, 4 in Tamil Nadu, 2 each in Gujarat, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra & Uttar Pradesh and 1 in Odisha).

#### 2.2 CWC Advisories

#### **Gujarat**

As IMD predicted very heavy to extremely heavy rainfall in Gujarat, alert for water level rise may be kept in rivers Banas, Sabarmati, Rel and other small rivers in Banaskantha, Pathan. Alert for water level rise may also be kept in rivers of Kutch, Jamnagar, Dwarka, Morbi, Rajkot, Surendranagar districts like Rukmavati, Khari-Mitti, Machhu, Bhadar, Sani, Ozat, Madhuwati, Megal and other small rivers in the area. In south Gujarat alert may be kept for water level rise in Tapi, Narmada, Damanganga and other small rivers in districts Dangs, Navsari and Valsad. The rivers of south Gujarat are now highly sensitive due to flood of near past. Soil moisture is very high and hence the surface flow created by any intense rainfall event is expected to be very high, hence all preparations to handle the situation may be taken.

#### Rajasthan

IMD as predicted very heavy rains in **Sirohi**, **Jhalawar**, **Baren**, **Kota and Ajmer**, **a**lert for water level rise may be kept in rivers West Banas, Chambal, Ahu, Parwan, Kalisindh and other small rivers in above said districts.

#### Daman, Dadra & Nagar Haveli

Since IMD has predicted very heavy rains in Daman, Dadra & Nagar Haveli, alert for water level rise may be kept in river Damanganga mainly.

#### Maharashtra

IMD has predicted heavy rains in **Palghar**, **Nasik**, **Pune and Amravati**, hence, alert may be kept for water level rise in rivers Purna (Tapi Basin), Wardha, Upper Godavari, Damanganga, Upper Bhima, rivers of north and middle Konkan and other small rivers in the said districts. **Projects in Amravati**, **Konkan and Nasik regions are having average storage of more than 70%**, hence, releases may be done as per SOP after informing lower riparian regions.

#### Madhya Pradesh


IMD has predicted very heavy rains in **Bhopal**, **Raisen**, **Rajgarh**, **Vidisha**, **Sehore**, **Agar Malwa**, **Shajapur and Guna**. **A**lert for water level rise may be kept in rivers Parbati, Kalisindh, Tapi, Narmada, Sindh, upper Betwa and its tributaries over the said regions.

#### 2.3 Flash Flood Guidance

## 24 hours Outlook for the Flash Flood Risk (FFR) till 1130 IST of 25.07.2022:

Moderate risk over few watersheds and neighborhoods of East Rajasthan, Gujarat region and West Madhya Pradesh Met subdivision in next 24 hours.

Surface runoff/ Inundation may occur at some fully saturated soils & low-lying areas over AoC as depicted in map due to persistent rainfall in next 24 hours.
