



1.1 Rainfall forecast for next 5 days issued on 25th June 2023 (Midday) by IMD



2.0 Flood Situation and Advisories


2.1 Summary of Flood Situation as per CWC Flood Forecasting Network

On 25th June 2023,2 stations (2 in Bihar) are flowing in Severe Flood Situation, 10 stations (7 in Assam & 1 in Jammu Kashmir) are flowing in Above Normal Flood Situation. Inflow Forecast has been issued for 2 Dams and Barrages in Tamil Nadu.

2.2 CWC Advisories

Assam

Since rainfall has decreased in Assam, abatement of water level is observed in most of the CWC hydrological sites located on Brahmaputra and its tributaries and it is expected to recede further in coming 2 to 3 days.

Bihar

Due to heavy rainfall in catchment of Nepal, river Bagamati flowed above danger mark in districts of Muzaffarpur and Sitamarhi. However, water level is expected to recede from tomorrow afternoon.

Uttarakhand

IMD has predicted very heavy to extremely heavy rains for next two days. Hence water level rise is expected in rivers such as Gola, Ramganga, Gomti, Pindar, Goriganga, Kalinadi, Bhagirathi, Alaknanda and other tributaries of rivers in upper Ganga in districts Uttarkashi, Bageshwar, Nainital, Chamoli, Rudraprayag, Champawat, Pauri Garhwal, Almora, Tehri Garhwal and Dehradun.

Orissa

Due to likelihood of formation of low pressure area Orissa and neighbourhood, heavy rains are expected in entire state mainly in districts **Kendujhar**, **Sundargarh**, **Deogarh**, **Jharsuguda**, **Baragarh**, **Bauda**, **Kandhamal**, **Kalahandi**, **Nuaparha**, **Nabarangapur**, **Anugul**, **Subarnapur**, **Balangir**, **Sambalpur**. Water level rise is mostly expected in rivers Indravati, Mahanadi, Brahmani, Baitarni and its tributaries in above districts in next two days. However, this being the first heavy rainfall this monsoon season, riverine flooding is not expected.

Himachal Pradesh


IMD has predicted heavy rains in districts **Kanger, Mandi, Shimla, Solan, Sirmaur, Chamba**, so water level rise is expected in river Tons and its tributaries in next two days.

2.3 Flash Flood Guidance

24 hours Outlook for the Flash Flood Risk (FFR) till 1130 IST of 26-06-2023:

Moderate flash flood risk likely over few watersheds & neighbourhoods of Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand Met Sub-divisions during next 24 hours.

Surface runoff/ Inundation may occur at some fully saturated soils & low-lying areas over AoC as shown in map due to expected rainfall occurrence in next 24 hours.
