




1.1 Rainfall forecast for next 5 days issued on 28th June 2023 (Midday) by IMD




2.0 Flood Situation and Advisories

2.1 Summary of Flood Situation as per CWC Flood Forecasting Network

On 28th June 2023, 4 stations (2 in Assam, 1 each in West Bengal & Uttar Pradesh) are flowing in Above Normal Flood Situation. Inflow Forecast has been issued for 2 Dams and Barrages in Tamil Nadu.

2.2 CWC Advisories

Uttarakhand

IMD has predicted very heavy to extremely heavy rains for next two days. Hence water level rise is expected in rivers such as Gola, Ramganga, Gomti, Pindar, Goriganga, Kalinadi, Bhagirathi, Alaknanda, Dhuilganga, Sarda, Kosi, Mandakini, Bhagirathi-I and other tributaries of rivers in upper Ganga in districts in almost all districts of Uttarakhand.

Sub-Himalayan West Bengal

IMD has predicted very heavy rainfall in Sikkim and over districts such as **Jalpaiguri**, **Alipurduar**, **Coochbihar** hence, water level rise is expected in rivers such as Jaldhaka, Raidak, Torsa, Sankosh and Teesta in above said districts.

Gujarat


IMD has predicted very heavy rains in **Bharuch**, **Surat**, **Navsari** and **Valsad** districts. Water level rise is expected in Lower Narmada, Lower Tapi, Damanganga, Purna, Ambika and other small rivers in the region for next two days.

2.3 Flash Flood Guidance

24 hours Outlook for the Flash Flood Risk (FFR) till 1130 IST of 29-06-2023:

Moderate flash flood risk likely over few watersheds & neighbourhoods of Uttarakhand Met Sub-divisions during next 24 hours.

Surface runoff/ Inundation may occur at some fully saturated soils & low-lying areas over AoC as shown in map due to expected rainfall occurrence in next 24 hours.



24 hours Outlook for the Flash Flood Risk (FFR) till 1130 IST of 29-06-2023:

Moderate flash flood risk likely over few watersheds & neighborhoods of Konkan & Goa and adjoining south of Gujarat Region Met Sub-divisions during next 24 hours.

Surface runoff/ Inundation may occur at some fully saturated soils & low-lying areas over AoC as shown in map due to expected rainfall occurrence in next 24 hours.




Extreme Flood Situation: (Site (s) where the previous Highest Flood Level (HFL) is exceeded or equalled).
