

2.2 Flood Situation as per actual/forecasted rainfall situation

Heavy to very heavy rainfall with isolated Extremely Heavy rainfall has been forecasted for Konkan & Goa on 2nd July and Heavy to Very heavy rainfall during the intervening days. Heavy to very heavy rainfall with isolated Extremely Heavy rainfall has been forecasted for Odisha, Chhattisgarh, Madhya Pradesh 3rd and 4th July. Heavy to Very Heavy rainfall has been forecasted in Andhra Pradesh and Telangana on 2ndJuly,

Due to the forecast rainfall in Odisha, Chhattisgarh, Vidarbha, Telangana and Andhra Pradesh, rivers in Mahanadi Basin, Rishikulya, Vamsadhara, Nagavali, Godavari and its tributaries such as Indravathi, Sabari and Pranhita are expected to rise. Inflows into various reservoirs may increase. However, as the present reservoir storages are very low in most of the basins, this may increase the storage in reservoir only and no major flooding may be anticipated.

Maharashtra: Raigad, Thane, Ratnagiri, Sindhudurg, and Districts of Vidarbha Sub-Division

Goa: North & South Goa

Karnataka: Uttara Kannada, Udupi and Dakshina Kannada

Odisha: Districts covering rivers Mahanadi, Indravathi, Sabari, Nagavali, Vamsadhara, Rushikulya

Chhattisgarh: Districts covering rivers Mahanadi, Indravathi and Sabari

Telangana: Districts covering rivers Wardha, Pranhita, Godavari, Maner, Manjira

Andhra Pradesh: Districts covering rivers Vamsadhara and Nagavali
