Subject:- Delegation of Powers in cases of settlement of medical reimbursement claims/ Permission/Grant of Medical Advance etc. under CGHS/CS(MA) Rules consolidated order.

The Ministry of Health and Family Welfare have delegated powers to the Head of Departments for settlement of individual medical reimbursement claims/to accord permission/grant of medical advance in connection with treatment under CGHS Rules for the monetary limits—upto ₹ 5,00,000/- (Rupees Five Lakhs only) vide its Office Memorandum No. S-11011/20/2014-CGHS(P)/EHSS, dated 23rd November, 2016 and upto ₹2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lakhs only) for treatment under CS(MA) rules, 1944 vide its O.M. No. S.14025/01/2014, dated 5th June, 2014 interalia to read with other orders issued from time to time.

- 2. A number of Office Orders were issued in the past by the Commission, for delegation of powers pertaining to various sort of medical claims and cases. However, for sake of convenience, need for issuing consolidated order has been realized time & again. Accordingly, power delegated to the officers of CWC in this regard are stipulated in Annexure-I. All the power thus delegated to CWC officers including cases for grant of medical advance are only upto monetary limit of ₹5,00,000/- (Rupees Five Lakhs only) under CGHS rules and upto ₹2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lakhs only) under CS(MA) rules. All cases beyond this limit need to be referred to Integrated Finance Division of the Ministry which have also been shown separately in Annexure-I.
- 3. This Office Memorandum is issued in supersession of all the previous orders, including No. 4/3/2000-O&M, dated 25.06.2001 and No. 4/2/2014-O&M/412, dated 16.03.2016 issued in this regard.
