3. Bids received on the CPP Portal (<http://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>) only will be considered. Bids in any other form sent through sealed cover/email/post/fax etc. will be rejected.
4. The bidder should fulfill the following eligibility criteria:

- a. The Agency should be registered with CPWD/similar agencies.
 - b. They should have a valid PAN No.
 - c. They should have a valid GST Registration No.
 - d. The firm should have work experience in Govt. sector/PSU.
 - e. The firm should not be blacklisted by any Central/State Govt./PSU.
5. The location of work is mentioned in Annexure -I, under Upper Krishna Division , Central Water Commission, Pune”
 6. Bids shall be submitted online only at the CPPP website <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>.
 7. Bidders are advised to follow the ‘Special Instructions to the Contractors/Bidders for the e-submission of the bids online’ available through the link ‘Help for Contractors’ at the e-Procurement Portal <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>.
 8. Bidder shall not modify the downloaded tender form including the downloaded price bid template in any manner. In case any tender form/Price bid template is found to be tampered with/modified in any manner, such bid will be summarily rejected, Bid Security would be forfeited, and the bidder would be liable to be banned.
 9. Bidders are advised to check the website <http://old.cwc.gov.in> and CPPP website <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app> at least 1 day before the closing date of submission of tender for any corrigendum, addendum, or amendment to the tender document.
 10. Tender Fees and Bid Security: The Tender fees of Rs. Nil/- and Earnest Money (Bid Security), Rs. Nil/- (Bid Securing declaration needs to be submitted).
 11. The firm, whose bid is accepted, will be required to furnish a performance guarantee of 3% (three percent) of the tendered amount within the period specified in Schedule ‘F’. This guarantee shall be in the form of deposit at call receipt of a scheduled bank/ fixed deposit receipt of a scheduled bank/ demand draft of scheduled bank/bank guarantee issued by a scheduled bank in accordance with the prescribed form. In case the firm fails to deposit the said performance guarantee within the period as indicated in Schedule ‘F’ including the extended period if any, the Earnest Money deposited by the contractor shall be forfeited automatically without any notice to the contractor.
 12. Tenders, in which the prescribed conditions are not fulfilled or are incomplete in any respect, are liable to be rejected.
 13. The competent authority on behalf of the President of India does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other bid and reserves to itself the authority to reject any or all the bids received without the assignment of any reasons.
 14. All bids in which any of the prescribed conditions are not fulfilled or any condition including that of the conditional rebate is put forth by the bidders shall be summarily rejected.
 15. Canvassing whether directly/ indirectly, in connection with tender is strictly prohibited and the tender submitted by a Tenderer who resorts to canvassing is liable to rejection.

16. The competent authority on behalf of the President of India reserves to himself the right of accepting the whole or any part of the bid and the bidders shall bound to perform the same at the rate quoted.
17. Validity Period of Tender: The offer for the work shall remain valid for acceptance for a period of 90 (Ninety) days from the date of opening of online bids.
18. If any firm withdraws its bid before the said period or issues of letter of acceptance, whichever is earlier, or makes any modifications in the terms and conditions of the bid which are not acceptable to the department, the bidders shall not be allowed to participate in the re-bidding process of the work.
19. It is suggested that the tenderer may acquaint themselves with the requirements of the work before submitting the tender.
20. No deviation in the payment terms mentioned in the tender document is permissible. The tenderer shall be deemed to agree with the payment terms mentioned in the tender document for submission of the bid.
21. The signing of the Contract Agreement:
 - a. INSTRUCTIONS TO TENDERERS

1. The bid prepared by the Tenderer, as well as all correspondence and documents relating to the bid exchanged by the Tenderer and the department shall be written in the English language. Supporting documents and printed literature furnished by the Tenderer may be in another language provided they are accompanied by an accurate translation of the relevant passages in the English language in which case, for purposes of interpretation of the Bid, the translation in the English Language shall govern.

2. Tender/Bid shall be accepted through only online mode on CPPP e-Procurement Portal <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>.

3. SUBMISSION OF DOCUMENTS

3.1. As part of the **Technical Bid**, signed and scanned copy of the following document must be uploaded:-

- (i) Copy of appropriate and valid registration certificate, valid PAN card, GST number
- (ii) Bid securing declaration.
- (iii) Copy of filled and signed form on page 8(**TENDER**) declaring acceptance of the tender clauses.
- (iv) Documents related to work experience of Govt sector/ PSU like completion certificate/ performance certificate.
- (v) Self-certified declaration of not been black by any Central /State Govt. /PSU.

Note: - Bid documents may be scanned with 100 dpi with black and white option which helps in reducing size of the scanned document.

3.2. As part of **Financial Bid**, following document must be uploaded:-

- (i) Duly Filled Price Bid in BoQ file format.

Note:

Bidders are required to download the BoQ file, open it and complete the blue colored (unprotected) cells with their respective financial quotes and other details (such as name of the bidder). No other cells should be changed. Once the details have been completed, the bidder should save it and submit it online, without changing the filename. If the BoQ file template is found to be modified by the bidder, the bid will be rejected.

4. Evaluation of Bids: Initially only the Technical Bids shall be opened and evaluated. If the bidder fully meets the qualifying criteria as specified in the bid document, only then his financial bid will be opened. The bids not meeting the qualifying criteria shall be deemed non-responsive. Such financial bids shall not be opened. Please Note: Conditional bids will be summarily rejected.

5. Rate shall be quoted in Indian Rupees only.

6. The Tenderer shall not contact the Department on any matter relating to its bid, from the time of the bid opening to the time the Contract is awarded. If the Tenderer wishes to bring additional information to the notice of the Department, it should do so in writing.

7. An affirmative determination will be a prerequisite for award of the work to the contractor.

PERFORMANCE GUARANTEE (CLAUSE - 1)

(I) The contractor shall submit on irrecoverable PERFORMANCE GUARANTEE of 3% (three percent) of the tendered amount in addition to other deposits mentioned elsewhere in the contract for his proper performance of the contract agreement, (notwithstanding and/or without prejudice to any other provisions in the contract) within 15 days of issue of letter of intent. This period can be further extended by the Engineer-in-charge up to a maximum period of 7 days on the written request of the contractor stating the reason for delays in procuring the Bank Guarantee, to the satisfaction of the Engineer-in-charge. This guarantee shall be in the form of Cash (in case guarantee amount is less than Rs.10,000/-) or Deposit at Call Receipt of any Scheduled Bank / Banker's Cheque of any Scheduled Bank / Demand Draft of any Scheduled Bank / Pay Order of any Scheduled Bank (in case of guarantee, the amount is less than Rs.1,00,000/-) or Government Securities or Fixed Deposit Receipts or Guarantee Bonds of any Scheduled Bank or the State Bank of India in accordance with the form annexed hereto. In case a fixed deposit receipt of only Bank is furnished by the contractor to the Government as part of the performance guarantee and the Bank is unable to make payment against the said fixed deposit receipt, the loss caused thereby shall fall on the contractor and the contractor shall forthwith on demand furnish additional security to the Government to make good the deficit.

(II) A letter of intent shall be issued in the first instance informing the successful tendered of the decision of the competent authority to accept his tender and the award letter shall be issued only after the Performance Guarantee in any of the prescribed form is received. In case of failure by the contractor to furnish the performance guarantee within the specified period, Government shall without prejudice to any other right or remedy available in law be at liberty to forfeit the earnest money absolutely.

(III) The Performance Guarantee shall be initially valid upto the stipulated date of completion plus 60 days beyond that. In case the time for completion of work gets enlarged, the contractor shall get the validity of Performance Guarantee extended to cover such enlarged time for completion of work. After recording of the completion certificate for the work by the competent authority, the performance guarantee shall be returned to the contractor, without any interest. (IV) The Engineer-in-charge shall not make a claim under the performance guarantee except for amounts to which the President of India is entitled under the contract (notwithstanding and / or without prejudice to any other provisions in the contract agreement) in the event of:-

(a) Failure by the contractor to extend the validity of the Performance Guarantee as described herein above, in which event the Engineer-in-charge may claim the full amount of the Performance Guarantee.

(b) Failure by the contractor to pay President of India any amount due, either as agreed by the contractor or determined under any of the Clauses / Conditions of the Agreement, within 60 days of the service of notice to this effect by Engineer-in-charge.

(V) In the event of the contract being determined or rescinded provisions of any of the clause / condition of the agreement, the Performance Guarantee shall stand forfeited in full and shall be absolutely at the disposal of the President of India.

We (indicate the name of the Bank) do hereby undertake to pay the amounts due and payable under this Guarantee without any demure, merely on a demand from the government stating that the amount \claimed is required to meet the recoveries due or likely to be due from the said contractor(s). any such demand made on the Bank shall be conclusive as regards the amount due and payable by the bank under this Guarantee. However, our liability under this guarantee shall be restricted to an amount not exceeding Rs..... (Rupees only).

3. We, the said Bank further undertake to pay to the Govt. any money so demanded notwithstanding any dispute or disputes raised by the contractor(s) in any suit or proceeding pending before any Court or Tribunal relating thereto, out liability under this present being absolute and unequivocal. The payment so made by us under this Bond shall be valid discharge of our liability for payment thereunder and the contractor(s) shall have no claim against us for making such payment.

4. We (indicate the name of Bank) further agree that the guarantee herein contained shall remain in full force and a fact during the period that would be taken for the performance of the said Agreement and that it shall continue to be enforceable till all the dues of the Govt. under or by virtue of the said Agreement have been fully paid and its claims satisfied or discharged or till Engineer-in-charge on behalf of the Govt. certified that the terms and conditions of the said Agreement have been fully and properly carried out by the said contractor(s) and accordingly discharges this guarantee.

5. We (indicate the name of Bank) further agree with the Government that the Government shall have the fullest liberty without our consent and without effecting in any manner our obligations hereunder to vary only of the terms and conditions of the said Agreement or to extend time of performance by the said contractor(s) from time to time or postpone for any time or from time to time any of the powers exercisable by the Govt. against the said contractor(s) and to for – bear or enforce any of the terms and conditions relating to the said Agreement and we shall not be relieved from our liability by reason of any such variation, or extension being granted to the said contractor(s) or for any forbearance, act of omission on the part of the Govt. or any indulgence by the Govt. to the said

Contractor(s) or by any such matter or thing whatsoever which under the law relating to sureties would, but for this provision, have effect of so relieving us.

6. This guarantee will not be discharged due to the change in the Constitution of the Bank or the contractor(s).

7. We (indicate the name of Bank) hereby undertake not to revoke this guarantee except with the previous consent of the Govt. in writing.

8. This guarantee shall be valid upto Unless extended on demand by Govt. Notwithstanding anything mentioned above, our liability against this guarantee is restricted to Rs. (Rupees.....) only and unless a claim in writing is lodged with us within six months of the date of expiry or the extended date of expiry of this guarantee all our liabilities under this guarantee shall stand discharged.

RECOVERY OF SECURITY DEPOSIT (CLAUSE 1A)

The person/persons whose tender(s) may be accepted (hereinafter called the contractor) shall permit Government of the time of making any payment to him for work done under the contract to deduct a sum at the rate of 2.5% of the gross amount of each running bill till the sum along with the sum already deposited as earnest money, will amount to security deposit of 2.5% of the tendered value of the work. Such deductions will be made and held by Government by way of Security Deposit unless he/they has/have deposited the amount of Security at the rate mentioned above in cash or in the form of Government Securities of fixed deposit receipts. In case a fixed deposit receipt of any Bank is furnished by the contractor to the Government as part of the security deposit and the Bank is unable to make payment against the said fixed deposit receipt, the loss caused thereby shall fall on the contractor and the contractor shall forthwith on demand furnish additional security to the Government to make good the deficit. All compensations or the other sums of money payable by the contractor under the terms of this contract may be deducted from, or paid by the sale of a sufficient part of his security deposit or from the interest arising therefrom, or from any sums which may be due to or may become due to the contractor by Government on any account whatsoever and in the event of his Security Deposit being reduced by reason of any such deductions or sale as aforesaid, the contractor shall within 10 days make good in cash or fixed deposit receipt tendered by the State Bank of India or by Scheduled Banks or Government Securities (if deposited for more than 12 months) endorsed in favour of the Engineer-in-charge, any sum or sums which may have been deducted from, or raised by sale of his security deposit or any part thereof. The security deposit shall be collected from the running bills of the contractor at the rates mentioned above.

NOTE – 1 : Government papers tendered as security will be taken at 3% (Three percent) below its market price or at its face value, whichever is less.

The market price of Government paper would be ascertained by the Divisional Officer at the time of collection of interest and the amount of interest to the extent of deficiency in value of the Government paper will be withheld if necessary.

NOTE – 2 : Government Securities will include all forms of Securities mentioned in rule No. 274 of the G.F. Rules except fidelity bond. This will be subject to the observance of the condition mentioned under the rule against each form of security.

NOTE – 3 : Note 1 & 2 above shall be applicable for both Clause 1 & 1A.

GENERAL INFORMATION AND ADDITIONAL TERMS & CONDITIONS OF THE CONTRACT

(A) DEFINITION OF TERMS USED

The “Agency/ contractor” shall mean the individual or firm or company and shall be included the legal personal representative or such individual or the persons comprising such firm or company and the permitted assignees of such individual or firm or company.

The “President” means the President of India and his successors.

The “Government” or “Government of India” shall mean the President of India.

The “Authority/ Tendering Authority” means the Executive Engineer, Central Water Commission, Upper Krishna Division, Pune.

(B) GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS OF THE CONTRACT

1. Language of the Bid:

All documents relating to the bid shall be in the English language. However, the documentary proofs such as registration certificate etc. can in English or local language.

1. Performance Guarantee/ Security Deposit:

- The successful bidder shall have to deposit an amount equal to 3% of the tendered and accepted value of the work as “Performance Guarantee” in favour of Executive Engineer, Central Water Commission, Upper Krishna Division, Pune on receipt of Acceptance letter in the form Demand draft, FDRs etc. within 15 days.
- Performance Guarantee will be forfeited in case, termination of the contract by the Department due to lapses on the part of the Contractor/successful Bidder.
- A sum of 2.5% of the gross amount of each bill shall be deducted as Security Deposit from the Bill. The security deposit will be released after six months from the date of record of completion of work.

3. Bid prices:

- a) The bid shall be for the full quantity as described in the schedule quantities & rates.
- b) Rates quoted shall be inclusive of all charges, taxes and other levies and incidental expenses, if any payable.
- c) The rates quoted by the bidders shall remain fixed for the duration of the contract and shall not be subject to adjustment on any account.
- d) No additional charges will be paid over and above the quoted rates of the Agency and the department shall also not pay any extra amount on any account.
- e) The rates shall be quoted in Indian Rupees only.

4. Bid validity:

Bid shall remain valid for the period of 90 days from the date of bid opening. In exceptional circumstances prior to the expiry of the original bid validity, the tendering authority may request the bidders to extend the period of bid validity in a specified additional period. The request and the response thereto shall be made in writing.

5. Corrupt and fraudulent practices:

It is expected that bidders under this contract observe the highest standard of ethics during the execution of this contract. In pursuance of this policy, the tendering authority;

a) Defines for purpose of these provisions, the terms set forth below as follows:

i) 'Corrupt practice' means the offering, giving, receiving or soliciting of anything of value to influence the action of a public official in the contract execution, and

ii) 'Fraudulent practice' means a misrepresentation of facts in order to influence the execution of a contract to the detriment of the tendering authority, and includes collusive practice among Bidders (prior to or after bid submission) designed to establish bid process at artificial non-competition levels and to deprive the tendering authority of the benefits of free and open competition.

b) Will reject a proposal for award of work if he determines that the Bidder recommended for award has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for contract in question.

6. Clarification of Bidding documents:

To assist in the examination, evaluation and comparison of bids, the tendering authority may in its discretion, ask any bidder for clarification of its bids. The request for clarification and the responses shall be in writing, but no change in the price or substance of the bid shall be sought or offered or permitted except as required to confirm the correction of arithmetic errors discovered by the tendering authority in the evaluation of the bids.

7. Examination of Bids and Determination of Responsiveness:

A substantially responsive bid is one that conforms to all the terms and conditions of the bidding document without material deviation or reservation. A material deviation or reservation is one which affects in any substantial way the scope, quality, or performance of the work and which limits in any substantial way inconsistent with the bidding documents, the tendering authority's rights or the bidder's obligations under the contract, or whose rectification would affect unfairly the competitive position of other bidders presenting substantially responsive bids.

If bid is not substantially responsive, it will be rejected by the tendering authority and may not subsequently be made responsive by correction or withdrawal and the no-confirming deviations or reservations.

8. Award criteria:

The tendering authority shall award the contract to the Bidder whose bid has been found to be responsive and who has offered the lowest evaluated Bid price.

9. Notification of Award:

The bidder whose bid has been accepted will be notified of the award by the tendering authority prior to expiration of Bid validity period.

10. Dispute Resolution Mechanism:

Any disputes arising on the contract will be referred to Superintending Engineer, Krishna & Coordination Circle, CWC, Hyderabad and his decision will be final and binding on bidder.

11. Signing of Contract:

The successful bidder, on acceptance of his bid by the Accepting Authority, shall, within 15 days from the stipulated date of start of the work, sign and execute the contract in the contract agreement form.

12. Changes in Contractor's organization to be approved:

Where the contractor is in partnership firm, the prior approval in writing of the tendering authority shall be obtained before making any change in the constitution of the firm.

13. Materials:

- All the construction material required for the construction work is to be procured in advance by the tenderer only. The Executive Engineer will not entertain any request of the tenderer in this regard for the delay in completion of work due to non-availability of any materials.
- The contractor shall bear all incidental charges for charge, storage and safe custody of the materials.

14. Safety Measures:

- In respect of all labour directly or indirectly employed in the work for the performance of the contractor's part of this agreement, the contractor shall at his own expense arrange for the safety provisions as per safety code framed from time to time by Government of India and shall at his own expense provide all facilities in connection therewith.
- Adequate precautions shall be taken to prevent danger from electrical equipment. No materials on the site of work shall be so stacked or placed as to cause danger or inconvenience to any person or the public.

15. Payment Terms:

- The payment will be released to the agency by the Executive Engineer after obtaining the running/Final Bill in triplicate from the Agency. The Bill should be enclosed along with certificate of work completion at site, countersigned by the concerned SDE/JE. The payment will be made on the basis of the actual measurements. Payments will be made through PFMS (for which necessary information shall have to be submitted by the agency) provided that the bill is submitted within time and with all documentary proofs as per tender clause. In case the agency submits incomplete bills and/or without necessary documentary proofs, the department shall not be held responsible for any delay in making payments.
- GST or any other tax applicable in respect of inputs procured by the contractor for this contract shall be payable by the Contractor and Government will not entertain any claim whatsoever in respect of the same. However, component of GST at time of supply of service (as provided in CGST Act 2017) provided by the contract shall be varied if different from that applicable on the last date of receipt of tender including extension if any.
- The "Tenderer" shall provide a Bank/Performance Guarantee in the prescribed Performance guarantee of 3% of tendered amount. The Bank/Performance Guarantee submitted by the "Tenderer" shall be valid up to 60 days beyond the completion of work. Security deposit of 2.5% of tendered amount shall be deducted from the bills as security deposit at the time of making the payments.
- For the purpose of this tender document "Tenderer", "Agency" and "Contractor" are synonymous.

16. Time schedule:

The entire work shall be completed within 45 days from the stipulated date of start of work in all respects. The work shall not be considered as complete until the Executive Engineer certifies in writing. The defects liability shall be commence from the date of such certificate.

17. Suspension of Work:

The contractor may be granted extension of time with the approval of Executive Engineer for the works delayed due to heavy rains, natural calamities etc. The contractor shall not be entitled to any compensation on account of such delay.

18. Penalty:

For any delay in completion of the work other than by reason of any exceptionally inclement weather, a penalty of @ 1.5% per month of Tendered amount of work.

19. Completion of Work:

Within 15 days of the completion of the work, the contractor shall give notice of such completion to the Executive Engineer and within 30(thirty) days of the receipt of such notice the Executive Engineer shall

inspect the work and if there is no defect in the work, shall furnish the contractor with a final certificate of completion.

20. Other terms and conditions:

- i) The contractor shall not employ the worker below the age of 18 years on the work.
- ii) All necessary steps taken for prompt rescue of any worker in danger and adequate provision should be made for prompt first aid treatment of all injuries likely to be sustained during the course of work.
- iii) The works should be completed satisfactory as per specification, drawing and in all respect as directed by the Executive Engineer.
- iv) The contractor shall make his own arrangements for obtaining electricity if required and water and make necessary payments directly to the department concerned.
- v) The work will be carried out in the manner complying in all respects with the requirements of relevant by-laws of the local body under the jurisdiction of which the work is to be executed or as directed by the Engineer-in-charge and nothing extra will be paid on this account.

22. All the works shall be executed as per latest CPWD specifications of works otherwise separately mentioned in the tender document.

23. Any other rules of CPWD codes and its amendment as applicable will be binding on the successful bidder for this tender.

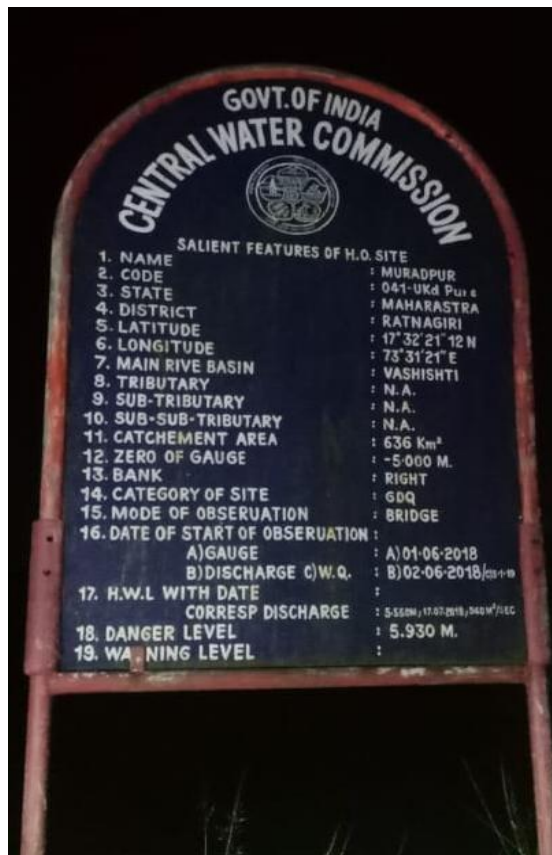

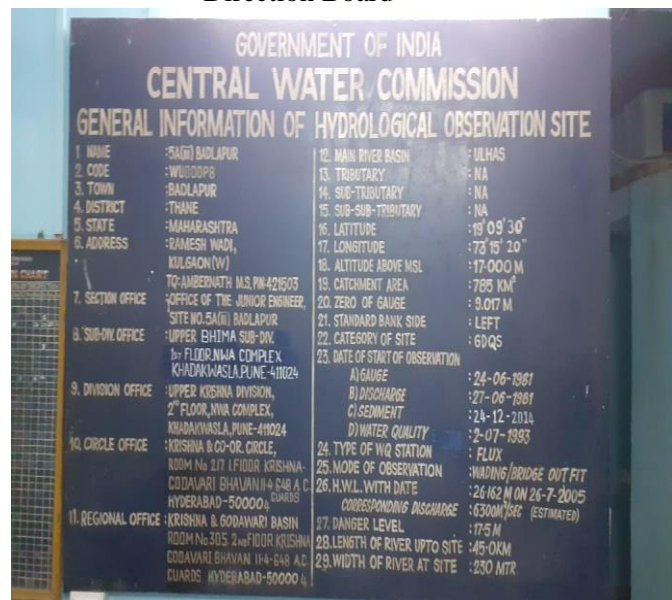
