1. Weather forecast by IMD

I. SYNOPTIC SITUATION:

- Yesterday's cyclonic circulation over south Pakistan & neighbourhood persists and now seen at 1.5 km above mean sea level.
- The western end of monsoon trough at mean sea level now runs from Ganganagar, Delhi and Bareilly and eastern end continues to run close to the foothill of the Himalayas.
- A north-south trough from southeast Uttar Pradesh to south Chhattisgarh at 5.8 km above mean sea level has become less marked.
- The Western Disturbance as a trough in mid-tropospheric westerlies with its axis at 5.8 km above mean sea level now runs roughly along Longitude 68°E to the north of Latitude 30°N.

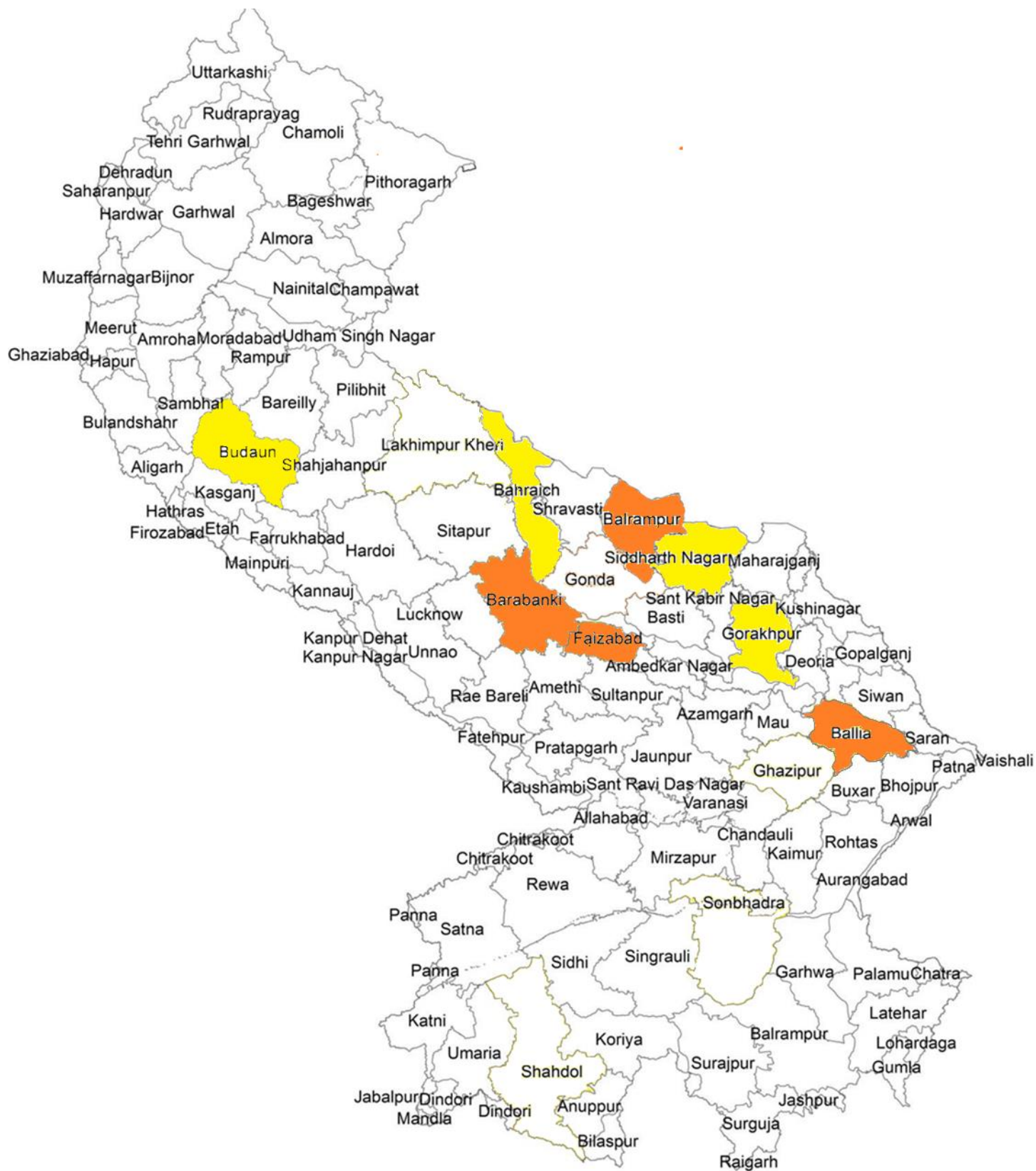

Advisory on Hydro Meteorological Situation Expected from 13-07-2020 to 14-07-2020

As per rainfall pattern given in section III, Alaknanda, Bhagirathi, rivers are expected to receive light rain Ganga River basin expected to receive heavy to moderate rain at isolated area in next 48 hrs. Ghaghra Ramganga, Sharda and Rapti river basins are expected to receive Moderate rain at isolated places in next 48 hours. Water level at most of CWC station is expected to Rise in next 48 hours. From the given QPF, above high flood like situation is expected in most of river basins. Level forecast will be issued if the level of river at stations is likely to touch or cross warning level.

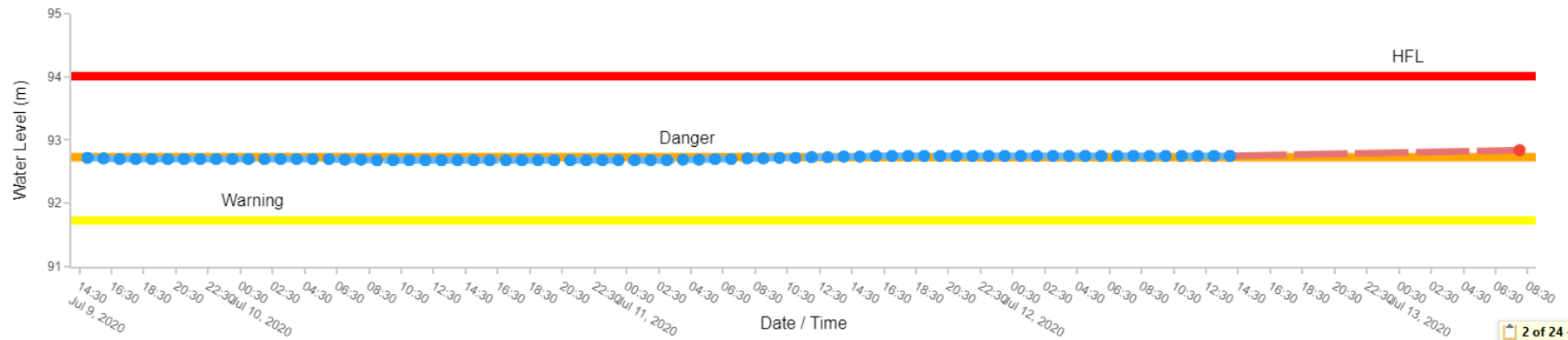

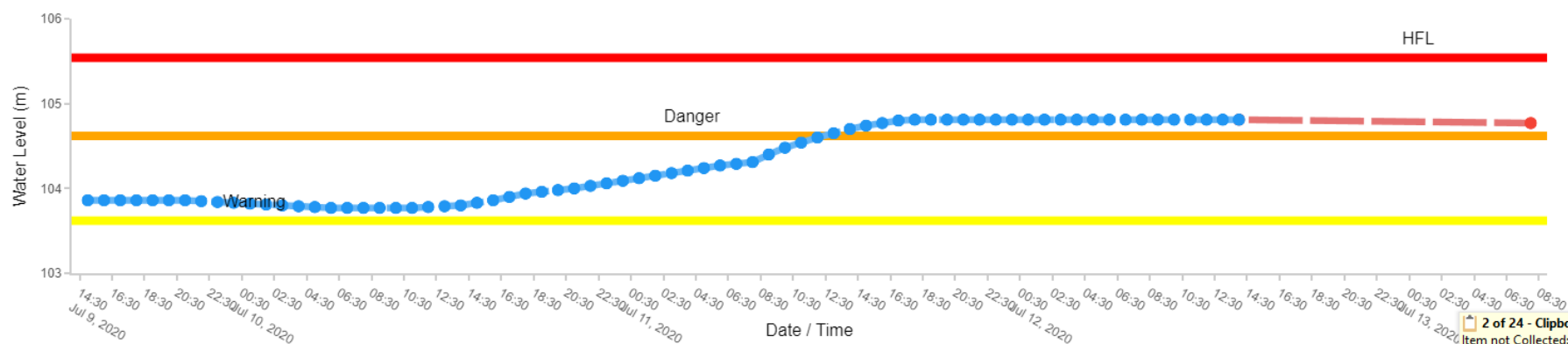

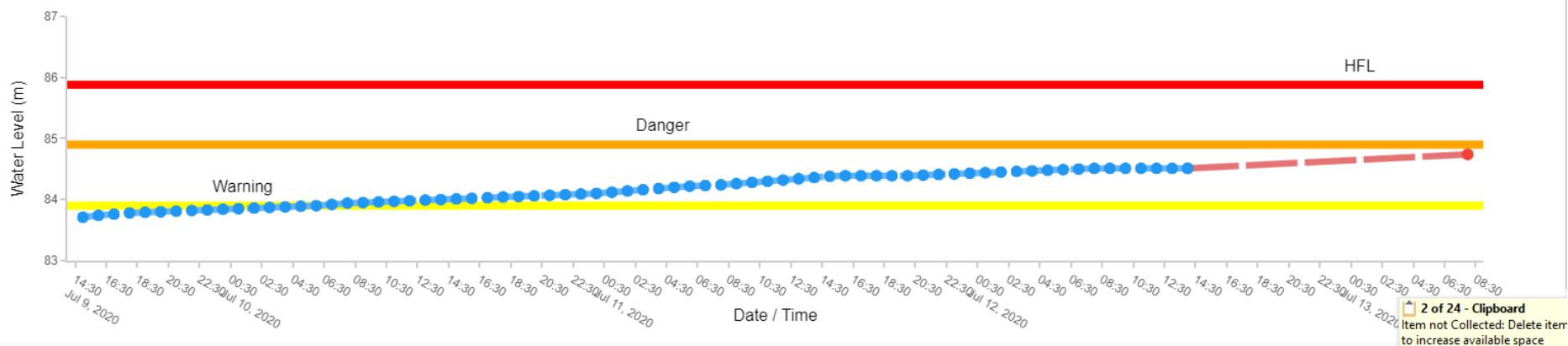

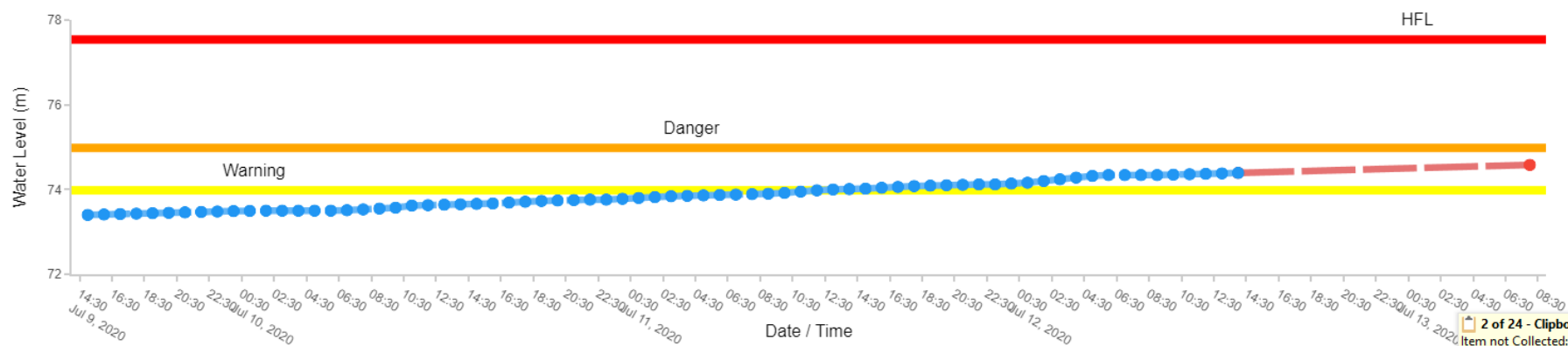

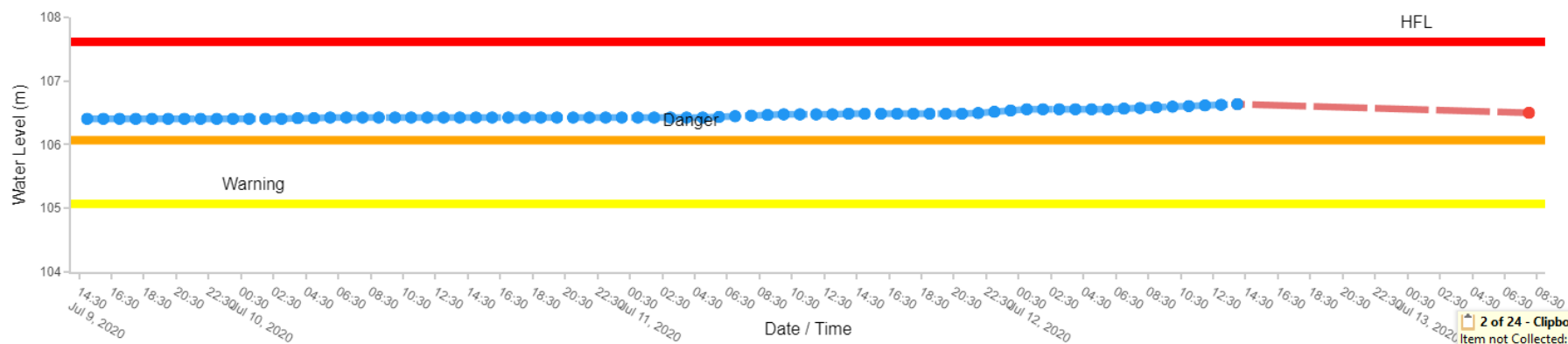

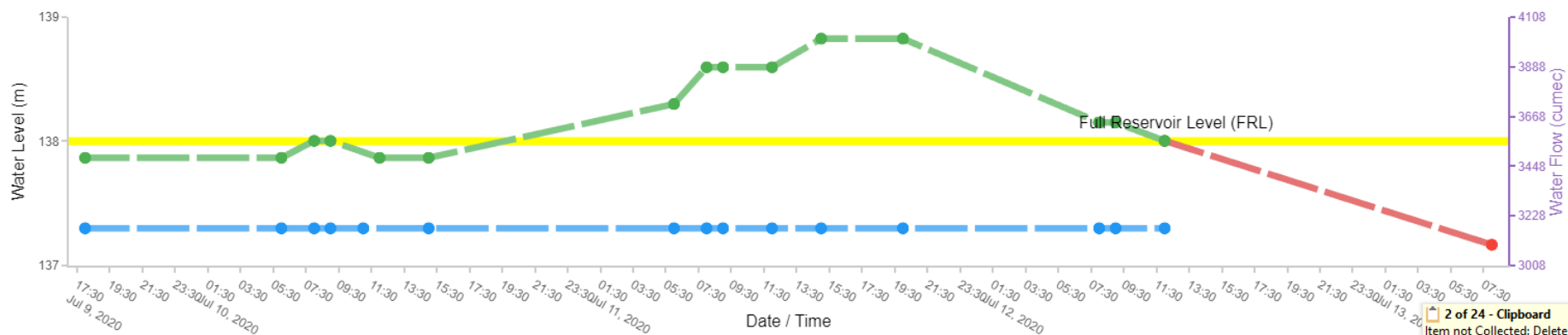

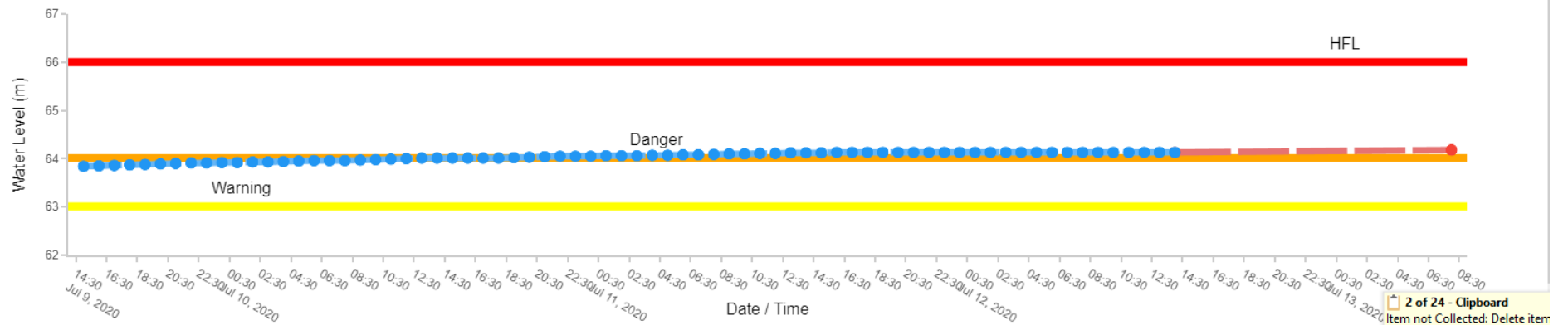
