ORDER

Whereas Shri Madhav Roy, C/o M. Crown Hotel, Police Bazar, Shillong, Meghalaya -793001 has preferred an appeal bearing Regd. No. nil dated 23.01.2024 against his RTI Application Regd. No. nil dated 13.12.2023.

And whereas, in his appeal, the Appellant has mentioned that he has not received reply to the point no. II in the RTI application dated 13.12.2023 regarding the report of the Committee considering the matter related to the various issues of regular and casual staff in Work-charge establishment at Bhutan Investigation Division (BID), CWC, Phuentsholing (Bhutan).

And whereas, it is stated that that no such report as mentioned in the appeal is available in the E.XII Section. The applicant has been already intimated the same vide CWC letter of even no. dated 27.12.2023.

And whereas, it is intimated that in order to examine the various issues of the regular and casual staff in Work-charged establishment at BID a committee consisting of the following officers was constituted with the approval of the Chairman, CWC:

Chief Engineer (YBO), CWC	- Chairman
Secretary, CWC	- Member
Director (RMCD), CWC	- Member
Accounts Officer/P&AO, CWC	- Member
Under Secretary (E.XII), CWC	- Member-Secretary

The minutes of the only meeting of the Committee is enclosed to Shri Madhav Roy, Shillong.

And whereas there is no fee for the appeal preferred by the applicant, the Indian Postal Order worth Rs.10, which was enclosed with his application is returned herewith.

Now, therefore, the appeal stands disposed of.

Minutes of the Meeting of the Committee to consider the various issues of the regular and casual staff in work-charged establishment at Bhutan Investigation Division (BID), CWC, Phuentsholing (Bhutan), held on 29.05.2017 at 10.30 AM in the Committee Room, Sewa Bhawan, R.K.Puram.

A Meeting of the Committee constituted to consider the various issues of the regular and casual staff in work-charged establishment at Bhutan Investigation Division (BID), CWC, Phuentsholing (Bhutan) was held on 29.05.2017 (Monday) at 10.30 AM in the Committee Room, Sewa Bhawan, R.K.Puram, under the Chairmanship of Sh. Ashok Goel, CE (YBO).

2. At the outset, the Chairman of the Committee welcomed all the members and invited their suggestions on the issues related to the matter. The following officers attended the meeting:

- (i) Sh. Ashok Goel, Chief Engineer (YBO), Chairman
- (ii) Sh. Ashis Banerjee, Secretary, CWC, Member
- (iii) Sh. Upendra Malhotra, Account Officer, CWC, Member
- (iv) Sh. H.S. Sengar, Director (RMCD), Member
- (v) Sh. Mahesh Yadav, Under Secretary, E-XII & Member Secretary

3. During the meeting, all the issues as per terms of reference of the Committee, were discussed in detail and based on the deliberations, the committee recommended that:-

(i) Firstly, all the 32 numbers of Work Charged Staff in different categories presently working under BID, Bhutan may be granted Indian pay scales as available to their counterparts in the work charged establishments of CWC subject to the condition that they will be transferred and posted against the vacant posts of SWA in the Circle offices under TBO, Siliguri (15 employees) B & BBO, Guwahati (12 employees) and LGBO, Patna (05 employees). However, before their transfer from BID, Bhutan to these three field offices with Indian pay scales, these 32 Work Charged Staff will be given an option (in enclosed proforma) to either remain posted at their present place of posting i.e. at BID, Bhutan with their existing pay scales or may be transferred to these three field offices of CWC in India with the Indian pay scales. Further after their transfer to the above mentioned field offices of TBO, Siliguri, B & BBO, Guwahati and LGBO, Patna, they will be placed at the bottom in the seniority list of SWA in the circle offices, where they will be posted. The inter-se seniority of these employees posted in a particular Circle office will, however be maintained.

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
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(ii) Once these 32 regular employees in Work Charged Establishment are adjusted as detailed above, the remaining 16 numbers of casual labours presently working at BID, Phuentsholing, CWC office, Bhutan may be given an offer of appointment as SWA against the vacant posts of SWA at different circle offices under TBO, Siliguri (08 employees) B&BBO, Guwahati (05 employees) and LGB0, Patna (03 employees). However, their appointment as SWA in these circle offices will have only prospective effect and they will not be allowed any benefit for their past service as casual labour. These casual labours will be given an option either to continue their present engagement as Casual labours in the O/o Bhutan Investigation Division (BID), CWC, Phuentsholing, Bhutan with existing pay scales or to join their new posting as SWA afresh with Indian pay scales. They will also be asked to give an undertaking, as per the enclosed format. These casual labour joining as SWA, will again be placed at the bottom of the seniority list of SWA in the respective circle office and will not have any claim for any benefit towards their casual service in the past.

(iii) In future, works will be carried out in BID, Bhutan through outsourcing and no fresh engagement of casual labour or posting of regular SWAs or any other category of Work Charge Staff will be made therein.

4. At the end the Chairman of the Committee thanked all the members for their valuable suggestions.


