Water being a State subject, steps for augmentation, conservation and efficient management of water resources are primarily undertaken by the respective State Governments. In order to supplement the efforts of the State Governments, Central Government provides technical and financial assistance to them through various schemes and programmes such as Repair, Renovation and Restoration (RRR) of Water Bodies as per guidelines of the scheme. Key objective of the scheme is Comprehensive improvement and restoration of water bodies, including protection works to avoid encroachment thereby increasing tank storage capacity. The other major objectives include Ground water recharge.</p> <p>2. Further, as per information available, GoI launched Jal Shakti Abhiyan (JSA) during Nov, 2019 which is focused on accelerated implementation of five target interventions, viz., water conservation &amp; rainwater harvesting, renovation of traditional and other water bodies/ tanks, reuse and recharge of bore wells, watershed development and intensive afforestation. This year also JSA has been undertaken, details in this regard may be available with National Water Mission (NWM).</p> <p>3. Further, Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare (MoA&amp;FW) is funding the works related to On-farm ponds under Per Drop More Crop (PDMC) which also aim to conserve water. The details may be available with MoA&amp;FW.</p>
