1	Details of different types and sources of Irrigation water availability in Sivaganga district, Tamil Nadu Year wise from 2010 to 2020	No Specific information is available. Applicant is requested to apply /contact concern Project Authority.
2	Details of different types of institutions and their roles on water conservation in Sivaganga district, Tamil Nadu year wise from 2010 to 2020	Water being a State subject, steps for augmentation, conservation and efficient management to ensure sustainability of water resources are undertaken by the respective State Governments. In order to supplement the efforts of the State Governments, Government of India provides technical and financial assistance to State Governments to encourage sustainable development and efficient management of water resources through various schemes and programmes namely <sup>a</sup> Accelerated Irrigation Benefits Programme (AIBP) <sup>o</sup> and <sup>a</sup> Repair, Renovation and Restoration(RRR) of Water Bodies <sup>o</sup> . Further, Surface Minor Irrigation (SMI) schemes with irrigation potential less than 2000 ha were included under Accelerated Irrigation Benefit Programme (AIBP) for providing Central Assistance (CA) since 1999-2000 for Special Category States. Subsequently the Scheme extended to area covering DPAP, Tribal, DDP, Flood prone, Left Wing extremist and Koraput, Bolangir and Kalahandi (KBK) region of Odisha. The water bodies under the minor irrigation schemes which have a maximum CCA of 2000 ha(Rural water bodies) and satisfying the criteria of minimum 5 ha of water spread area in case of rural water bodies and 2-10 ha water spread area in case of urban water bodies are eligible to be included under the scheme RRR of water bodies. This is a continuing scheme since X Plan and is presently being implemented during XII Plan and onwards also. The schemes, Surface Minor Irrigation (SMI) and RRR of water bodies are now part of Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (PMKSY)-Har Khet ko pani (HKKP). Recently, Ministry of Jal Shakti has launched Jal Shakti

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		Abhiyan - a campaign for water conservation and water security. The focus of the campaign was on water stressed districts and blocks through key intervention areas like water conservation and rainwater harvesting, renovation of traditional and other water bodies/tanks, reuse and recharge structures, watershed development and intensive afforestation. Jal Shakti Abhiyan aims at making water conservation a Jan Andolan through asset creation and extensive communication.
3	Provide the details of any externally aided project on water conservation related to irrigation in Sivaganga district, Tamil Nadu, year wise from 2010 to 2020	<p>The PPR of project proposal titled <sup>a</sup>Irrigated Modernization and Water Resources Management Project, Phase-II<sup>o</sup> submitted by Govt. of Tamil Nadu for world Bank funding was received by CWC in may 2015. The same was examined and recommended to erstwhile MoWR, RD &amp; GR on 11.06.2015.</p> <p>Further, modernization irrigation infrastructure in selected 66 sub-basins in Tamil Nadu was one of the component under the said proposal. As per available index map with PPR, it shows that part of two number of sub-basins namely Uppar River and Lower Vaigai lies in Sivaganga district, Tamil Nadu.</p>
4	Give the details of successful irrigation projects in India and more specifically in Sivaganga district in Tamil Nadu year wise from 2010 to 2020.	<p>Ministry of Jal Shakti (erstwhile MoWR,RD&amp;GR), Government of India launched a State Sector Scheme for Repair, Renovation &amp; Restoration (RRR)of Water Bodies with two components, one with domestic support and another with external assistance for implementation during XI Plan. Under the scheme with domestic support, a total of 3341 water bodies were taken up for restoration in 12 States. Out of which, 3114 water bodies have been completed till date. Under the scheme with External Assistance, 8747 water bodies were taken up for restoration in four States namely, United Andhra Pradesh(2364), Karnataka(1047), Odisha(324) and Tamil Nadu (5012). So far, 8054 water bodies reported to be completed. Out of which, 5009 water bodies belongs to Tamil Nadu.</p> <p>The Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs chaired by Hon'ble Prime Minister has accorded approval of Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (PMKSY) in its meeting held on 1st July, 2015.</p> <p>The scheme <sup>a</sup><b>RRR of water bodies<sup>o</sup></b> is now part of PMKSY (Har Khet ko pani,HKKP).</p>

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		<p>Under the scheme RRR of Water Bodies, a total of 2219 water bodies have been taken up for restoration since XII Plan onwards, out of which 242 water bodies belongs to Tamil Nadu. So far, RRR works on 153 water bodies of Tamil Nadu have been completed.
