Subject: Conducting of Level-4 Mandatory Cadre Training Programme for SAG officers of CWES (Group-A) for 2nd batch to be held at IIM, Ahmadabad during 18-22 April, 2022 – regarding.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to CWC's letter dated 17.03.2022 on the subject mentioned above and to convey the approval of Secretary (WR, RD &GR) for the nomination of the Senior Administrative Grade (SAG) officers of Central Water Engineering (Group-A) Service (CWES), whose names are mentioned in the Annexure of this letter, for participation in the Level-4 of Mandatory Cadre Training Program (MCTP), to be held at IIM, Ahmadabad, during April 18 – 22, 2022. Officers as mentioned in the Annexure may be relieved from their duties and advised to report to Programme Coordinator – Executive Education, IIM, Ahmadabad, New Campus, Vastrapur, Ahmedabad, on 18.04.2022.

- 2. In terms of the approved Training Policy of this Department, successful completion of Level-4 Training is mandatory for promotion to the Higher Administrative Grade of CWES. Therefore, CWC is requested to ensure that nominated officers are relieved in time. The performance of the officers in the training will be evaluated and Performance Reports shall be added in the APARs of CWES Officers while considering their promotion. No request for withdrawal/ exemption from the officers concerned shall be entertained except on medical grounds, as mentioned in the approved Training Policy.
- 3. Your attention is also drawn to this Department's letter No. A.33025/17/2019-Estt.I dated 28.02.2019, vide which approved MCTP Policy for all levels has been issued. Guidelines contained in the aforesaid letter, under the heading "Exemption for various Mandatory Training/ In-Service training programmes for the officers of CWES in respect of MCTPs which are reproduced below:

a. All phases of the Mandatory Cadre Training/In-Service Training Programmes shall be attended by all officers in the first chance when it falls due. CWES officers will be given a maximum of two chances to complete each level of the Mandatory Cadre Training Programme available to them.

Postponement of participation from the first chance to the second chance would be allowed with the prior approval of the Chairman, CWC. However, such approval for postponement of the participation does not entitle the officer to obtain their respective promotion/ grade/ increment in relaxation of the Rules. It is reiterated that the officer will be entitled to respective promotion only after he/she successfully completes the respective MCTP for CWES.

c. CWES officers deputed by the Department to a foreign assignment may be permitted to attend the mandatory training on return from such assignment for promotion to next grade.

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d. Officers who do not attend the mandatory training programmes even after the second nomination by the CWC/ Department shall be debarred from future training programmes under the Cadre Training Plan and will not be promoted to their next higher grade in the service.

e. Administrative action may be taken to deny the grant of promotion to such debarred officers.

- f. In case the officer leaves the training, in between the programme, other than on emergent medical grounds, the entire cost of training shall be recovered from such officer for non-completion of
- g. The officer nominated for training shall be relieved for by the respective Head of the Regional Office/ Directorate etc., as it is mandatory.
- h. For postponement of Training, serious/ chronic illness recommended by the competent medical authority in the prescribed forum, pre-natal-post-natal conditions recommended by the competent medical authority in the prescribed forms for female probationers, and sudden demise of immediate family members will only be considered.
- No leave other than on emergent medical grounds of self, spouse and own children and parents shall be granted, generally, for not more than three days. Attendance of officers in any of the training programmes mentioned above is a must and if the attendance is less than 90% he/she will not be declared as "qualified". There will be no absenteeism in one week duration MCTPs.
- 4. In the Training Course of 1 Week duration, no Leave shall be granted.
