

2.	How many Posts of LDC are vacant under subordinate offices of Central Water Commission and what efforts are being made to fill up the vacancies.	
3.	What is the criterion for promotion of Multi Tasking staff of Subordinate offices to the post of LDC.	
4.	How many Multi tasking staff has been promoted to the post of LDC Since 2015.	
5.	Is there any provision in Central Water Commission for conducting Special Exam for qualified Multitasking staff to the post of LDC or they are eligible for only Fitness cum Seniority criteria	
6.	What is the ratio between the direct recruitment through Staff Selection to the post of LDC, and promotion of Multi tasking staff to LDC on basis of fitness cum seniority basis criteria.	
7.	Is there a provision for Ad-hoc promotion of Multi tasking staff to LDC. If so what is the procedure for the same.	
8.	What is the minimum amount of regular service required for promotion to various stages i.e. from MTS to LDC, LDC to UDC, UDC - Assistant, and Assistant to Section Officer	
9.	Please provide information about the procedure to be followed by as SC/ST employee working in MoWR, RD & GR or Central Water Commission for seeking permission from the office for filing criminal complaint under SC/ST Atrocity Act.
