


Central Water Commission Special Flood Advisory for Kerala, Tamil Nadu, Andhra Pradesh 03-11-2021

1.0 Rainfall Situation

- 1.1 Basin wise departure from normal of daily rainfall & Significant amount of Rainfall (from 0830 hrs IST of yesterday to 0830 hours IST of today) (1 cm or more):
 - Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal: Thanjavur-17, Cuddalore-14, Nagapattinnam-13, Pudujottai-12, Perambalur-11, Mayiladuthrai-10, Ramanathapuram-9, Karur, Tiruvarur-8, Ariyalur, Chengalpattu, Villupuram-7
 - Kerala & Mahe: Thrissur-11, Kozhikode-8, Cannur-7, Kottayam-6, Cochin-3
 - Rayalseema: Kamalapuram-11, Vallur-8, Utukuru and Cuddapah-7 each, Tirupathi-4;
 - North Interior Karnataka: Kalaburgi-7, Gulbarga-6
 - Goa: Panjim-2
 - Telangana: Jangaon-7
 - Coastal Andhra Pradesh: Narsapur-3
 Anderson & Nischer Islander Con Nisch
 - Andaman & Nicobar Islands: Car Nicobar-3






Notes: a) Small figures indicate actual rainfall (mm), while bold figures indicate Normal rainfall (mm)

1.2 Rainfall forecast for next 5 days issued on 03rd November, 2021 (Midday) by IMD



Isolated Very Heavy Rainfall over Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal on 03^{rd} ; over Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam on 03^{rd} & 07^{th} and over Kerala & Mahe on 03^{rd} & 04^{th} November, 2021

2.0 CWC Advisories

2.2.1 Tamil Nadu

Alert may be kept in districts **Cuddalore, Mayiladuthurai, Nagapattinam, Tiruvarur, Thanjavur & Pudukkottai**. Water level rise is expected in rivers (particularly in delta areas) Vellar, Cauvery, Pennar, Agniar, Pambar and Palar. Reservoirs such as Mettur, Bhavanisagar, Amaravathi, Papanasam, Pechiparai, Perunchani, Sholayar and Thirumurthy dam are 80 to 100 percent filled up, hence water releases from the said dams, if required, may be done as per SOP after informing downstream districts in advance. Currently, Bhavani (Coimbatore dist.)& Marudaiyar (Ariyalur dist.) are flowing in above normal flood situation with steady trend.

2.2.2 Kerala

Alert may be kept in districts such as **Thiruvananthapuram**, **Kollam**, **Pathanamthitta**, **Kottayam**, **Ernakulam**, **Idukki**, **Wayanad**, **Kozhikode**, **Kannur & Kasaragode**, and watch may be kept in rivers Karamana, Neyyar, Vamanapuram, Kallada, Ithikkara, Manimala, Achankovil, Pampa, Moman, Pallickal, Periyar, Kabini, Kuttyadi, Chaliyar, Korapuzha, Valapatnam, Chandragiri and other small rivers in north Kerala. Currently, rivers Manimala and Achankovil in Pathanamthitta district are flowing in above normal flood situation with falling trend. Water releases from Idukki, Idamalayar, Mullaperiyar may be done, if required, after informing downstream areas in advance.

2.2.3 Andhra Pradesh

Alert may be kept in districts such as **Vizianagaram**, **East Godavari** and **Vishakapatanam**. Water level rise is expected in delta areas of rivers Godavari, Krishna and its tributaries.
