


## Central Water Commission Special Flood Advisory for Kerala, Tamilnadu, Karnataka 12-10-2021

### 1.0 Rainfall Situation


### 1.1 Basin wise departure from normal of cumulative and daily rainfall



### 2.0 CWC Advisories

### 2.1 Special Advisory for Kerala

Vigorous rainfall activity in Kerala from last 2 days has created severe to above normal flood situation in southern and central parts of Kerala, mainly in districts **Trivandrum**, **Kollam**, **Pattanamthitta & Palakkad**. Presently, rivers Neyyar, Karamana & Vamanapuram (**Trivandrum** dist.); Ithikkara river (**Kollam** dist.); Manimala river (**Pattanamthitta** dist.), Bhavani river (**Palakkad** dist.) are following in above normal flood situation with rising trend. Rivers Achankovil (**Pattanamthitta** dist.) is following in severe flood situation with rising trend. River Pulanthodu (**Palakkad** dist.) is following in above normal flood situation with rising trend. As per CWC observed data, the sites where rivers are following in severe and above normal flood situation are given below.



As per the weather forecast issued by IMD, intense rainfall activity will continue in Kerala for next 3 to 4 days. Alert may be kept in districts **Kasaragod, Kannur, Kozhikode, Wayanad, Malappuram, Thrissur, Palakkad, Ernakulam & Idukki**. Watch needs to be kept for rivers Shiriya, Payaswani, Chandragiri, Kudhirapuzha, Kadalundi, Chaliyar, Kuttyadi, Iruvazhinjipuzha, Kabini, Valapatnam (North Kerala); Chalakudy, Gayatri, Keecheri, Periyar, Kaliyar Kothamangalam, Muvattupuzha, Bhavani, Bharathapuzha, Kannadipuzha, Pilanthodu, Thodupuzha (Central Kerala) and tributaries of above mentioned rivers. Flood affected and Flood alerted regions are shown below.

Heavy rainfall in Nilgris and Coimbatore will rise water level in Bhavani river and its tributaries (Palakkad dist.). Water levels are expected to cross Danger Level in rivers such as Bharathapuzha, Periyar, Chalakudi, rivers of North Kerala and its tributaries.

Dams such as Idukki, Idamalayar, Kakki, Banasura, Mattupetti, Sholayar, Poringalputtu, Kundala, Kallarkuzhi are having high storages. Increased inflows are expected to theses dams. Releases from these dams may be done as per SOP after informing low lying areas in advance.

## 2.2 Special Advisory for Tamil Nadu

Alerts may be kept in districts **Nilgris**, **Coimbatore and Erode**. Watch needs to be maintained for rivers Ponnaiyar and the tributaries of Cauvery mainly Bhavani and Amaravathi. Currently, river Kodaiyar is flowing in severe flood situation in **Kanyakumari** district with falling trend. River Ponnaiyar (East flowing rivers between Pennar and Kanyakumari basin) is flowing in above normal flood situation with rising trend. River Thambraparni and Marudaiyar (Cauvery basin) are flowing in above normal flood situation with falling trend.

# 2.3 Special Advisory for Karnataka

Currently, river Shimsa is flowing in severe flood situation in Mandya district. River Arkavathi is flowing in above normal flood situation with rising trend in Bengaluru (Rural). Alert may be kept in districts **Shimoga, Chickmagalur, Hassan, Tumkur, Mandya, Mysore & Kodagu.** Water level is expected to rise in rivers such as Pennar, tribuarties of Krishna such as Bhadra, Tunga, Cauvery and its tributaries such as Hemavathi, Shimsha, Yagachi, Hebbahalla, Kabini, Lakshmanthirtha, Harangi etc. All the major dams in Krishna and Cauvery basins are having high storages, hence releases from these dams may be done as per SOP after informing low lying areas in advance.
