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GENERAL INSTRUCTION TO BIDDERS

- 1.0 Bids shall be submitted online only at CPPP website URL https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app. Tenderer/Contractor are advised to follow the instructions provided in the 'Instructions to the Contractors/Tenderer for the e-submission of the bids online through CPPP portal. The tender notice is also available at www.cwc.gov.in.
- 2.0 Not more than one tender shall be submitted by one contactor or contractors having business relationship. Under no circumstance will father and his son(s) or other close relatives who have business relationship with one another (i.e. when one or more partner(s)/director(s) are common) be allowed to tender for the same contract as separate competitors. A breach of this condition will render the tenders of both parties liable to rejection
- 3.0 Tenderer who has downloaded the tender from the CPPP website URL https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app shall not tamper/modify the tender form including price bid template in any manner. In case if the same is found to be tempered/modified in any manner, tender will be completely rejected and EMD would be forfeited.
- 4.0 Intending tenderers are advised to visit again CPPP website https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app and CWC website www.cwc.gov.in at least 2 days prior to closing date of submission of tender for any corrigendum / amendment.
- 5.0 Applicant contractor must provide demand draft for **Rs 500/- (Rupees Five Hundred only**) in favour of Executive Engineer, Upper Yamuna Division, CWC, New Delhi obtained from any Nationalized/ scheduled Bank with their application/downloaded tenders as the cost of tender forms/ documents. All applicable bank charges shall be borne by the applicant and he shall not have any claim what so ever on this account on department. In case of re-tendering, the firms which have submitted the DD in earlier calls will require to submit DD along with their tender/application in subsequent calls also. 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7.2 The financial bid will be opened only for those bidders who qualify the eligibility criteria as per the tender document as a part of technical bid.

The bidder has to submit following documents in hard copy in a sealed envelope before last date of opening of online bid otherwise the bid will not be considered for opening:

- 9.0 Financial bid with service charge less than 5% of minimum wages are liable to be rejected, irrespective of technical or otherwise eligibility.
- 10.0 In case of tie of lowest financial bid among the eligible bidders, tender will be awarded as per following criteria:

According to One of the Maximum amount of similar work* completed satisfactory for central/state Govt./PSU department in last three year (from 1st Jan 2017 to 31st Dec.2019).

- * Similar work means providing the services of Data Entry Operator and watch and ward with or without arms in central/state Govt./PSU department.
 - a) The financial bids will be opened only of those bidders whose technical bids would be complete in all respects as per tender document. In the Financial Bids, if the service charge per person quoted is less than 5% of the basic minimum wages*, the quotation will be rejected out rightly. Further, in case the same lowest rate is quoted by more than one eligible firm, the selection will be based as per above criteria.

^{*}Monthly Wages (25 days of DEO and 30 days of Unarmed Security Guard) should not be less than Minimum wages for area category A – Rs. 733/day as per Order F.No. 1/36(3) /2018-LS-II & F.No. 1/36(6) /2018-LS-II daed 23-09-2019 of Chief Labour Commissioner (C), New Delhi, Govt. of India.

3.0 ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS FOR THE TENDERERS

- 1.0 The contractor should be registered with EPF and ESIC and have a valid certificate of EPF and ESI department.
- 2.0 They should have a Valid PAN No. (copy to be enclosed).
- 3.0 They should have a Valid GSTIN Registration No. (copy to be enclosed).
- 4.0 The Firm should have a minimum experience of last three financial years*(2016-17, 2017-18 & 2018-19) in the field of providing outsourcing Manpower for Government/public Sector undertaking
- 5.0 The firm should have successfully completed following works during last five financial years* (2014-15,2015-16,2016-17,2017-18 & 2018-19).
 - (a) Three similar works of individual value not less than Rs. 4.63 Lakh or
 - (b) Two works each costing not less than Rs. 6.95 Lakh or
 - (c) One work costing not less than Rs. 9.26 Lakh.

- 6.0 Average Annual financial turnover of related services during the last three years, ending 31st March of the previous financial year, should be at least Rs. 11.57 Lakhs.
- 4.0 **Verification of Details:** Superintending Engineer, HOC, CWC, 285, Sector-1, Vaishali, Ghaziabad (UP) reserves the right to verify the particulars furnished by the Tenderer independently. If any information furnished by the Tenderer is found to be incorrect at a later stage, his / her Earnest Money / performance guarantee shall be forfeited and he / she shall be debarred from tendering for the works of CWC in future.
 - 5.0 **Agreement:** Agreement shall be drawn with the successful tenderer on prescribed Form No CPWD 7/8 (enclosed). Tenderer shall quote their rates as per terms and conditions of the said form, which shall form part of the agreement.

 - 8.0 Visit to Work Place by Tenderer: Tenderers are encouraged to inspect and examine the work places and its surroundings and satisfy / apprise themselves as to the nature of the work, the means of access and in general, shall obtain themselves all necessary information as to risks, contingencies and other circumstances which may influence or affect their tender and rates, before submitting their tenders. 1. Scope of work:

- A) 1 no. Data Entry Operator (DEO) @ 733/- Per day x25= 18325/- per month
- B) 2 nos. Watch & Ward Service to HOC,CWC, Vaishali (2 nos. x 12 months @ 733/- per day X 30 days = 21,990/- per month
 - 1.2 The duration of this Contract shall be for a period of 12 months. The successful Tenderer shall be expected to provide the services during the specified contract period on Contract Basis (or extended period on mutual consent, if any) as described in the contract.

2. Penalty Clause:

- a) In case, any person providing the services as per the schedule of work is found to be absent from duty, twice the amount of wages for the period of absence will be deducted from the bill.
